HIS WIFE, MARILYN, HAS TAUGHT HOME ECONOMICS IN HIGH SCHOOL AND JUNIOR HIGH.

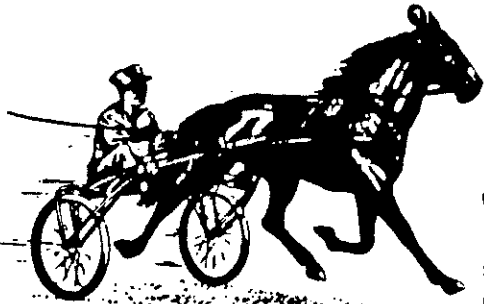

THE COMMITTEE MET WITH GLEN DOBBS WHO REPRESENTS THE OWNERS OF THE HOLLIDAY INN, AND THROUGH THE DISCUSSION OF THE EVENING, IT APPEARED THAT GREAT DAMAGE WOULD COME TO THE LAND AT LAWRENCE EXPRESSWAY AT BAYSHORE, AND TO MANY VILLAGE HOMES IF THE BRIDGEWOOD WAY INTERSECTION WAS NOT LEFT OPEN. MR DOBBS STATED THAT THE OWNERS WOULD LIKELY NOT HAVE BOUGHT THE LAND IF IT HAD BEEN KNOWN THAT THE ONLY ENTRANCE WOULD HAVE BEEN THROUGH A RESIDENTIAL STREET.

WE LEARNED THAT THE LAND WAS WORTH ABOUT \$30,000.00 AN ACRE AND THE FIVE ACRES BOUGHT FOR THE MOTEL WILL HAVE 120 UNITS STARTED IMMEDIATELY AND 80 UNITS IN THE NEAR FUTURE, ALSO A RESTAURANT IS PLANNED.

MR DOBBS SAID HE IS GOING TO CONTACT THE CITY AND COUNTY IMMEDIATELY AND GIVE A REPORT ON WHAT HE CAN DO WITHIN A FEW DAYS.

THE COMMITTEE IS CALLING THE CITY AND COUNTY ASKING WHAT TYPE OF FORM IS USED FOR A PETITION OF PROTEST, THEN WILL MEET AGAIN JULY 23 AND DISCUSS THE FINDINGS OF MR DOBBS AND ORGANIZE TO CIRCULATE THE PETITIONS.

ROADS COMMITTEE MEETING JULY 12

THE COMMITTEE GOT TOGETHER WITH A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEVELOPER OF THE LAND TO BE OUR NEW SHOPPING CENTER AT BAYSHORE AND LAWRENCE EXPRESSWAY, AND FOUND THAT THE OWNER WAS UNDER THE IMPRESSION THAT BRIDGEWOOD WAY WAS TO BE OPEN UNDER A VERBAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE, WHEN THE LAND WAS SOLD TO THE STATE FOR THE OFF RAMP AND FRONTAGE ROAD. WE ALSO LEARNED THAT THE HOLLIDAY INN WILL BE STARTED WITHIN 30 DAYS, PROBABLY BEFORE THE NEXT L.V.R.A. MEETING AUGUST 6. ANYONE INTERESTED IN SEEING WHAT IS PROPOSED IN THE CENTER, SEE ME AT THE MEETING OR STOP BY THE HOUSE.

WE DISCUSSED CLOSING BRIDGEWOOD WAY AS PROPOSED BY THE CITY AND COUNTY, BUT FELT THIS WAS COMPLETELY OUT BECAUSE ABOUT TWO THOUSAND CARS A DAY WOULD BE GOING DOWN BLAZINGWOOD DRIVE, WHICH IS A RESIDENTIAL STREET, TO GET TO SANDIA. WE ALSO DISCUSSED PUTTING IN A SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION AND FELT THAT THIS WOULD BE THE BEST WAY TO GET THE TRAFFIC OUT OF THE VILLAGE BUT WE WERE AFRAID THE TRAFFIC OVER THE BRIDGE WOULD STACK UP, AND BECAUSE OF THE ARC IN THE BRIDGE ACCIDENTS WOULD OCCUR AS WE'RE SURE THE CITY FELT.

THE COMMITTEE DISCUSSED LEAVING BRIDGEWOOD WAY OPEN WITH ONLY RIGHT HAND TURNS AVAILABLE SO THE TRAFFIC COULD GET IN FROM BAYSHORE AND THE CARS GOING OUT COULD TURN RIGHT, AND THEN MAKING A "U" TURN AT THE SANDIA INTERSECTION.

THE COMMITTEE LEARNED THAT THE CITY HAS TURNED THE EXPRESSWAY OVER TO THE COUNTY AND THE COMMITTEE IS GOING TO SEE THE COUNTY ABOUT THE PROBLEM AND WILL GET TOGETHER AGAIN JULY 18. THE COMMITTEE IS, CHAIRMAN; ROY DUNCAN, DICK LOFTON, MURRELL BEAL, RAY HARVEY, BEN SCHMIDT AND FRED GUPTILL.

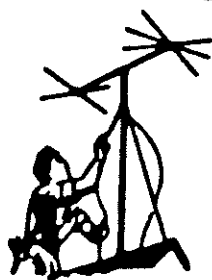
