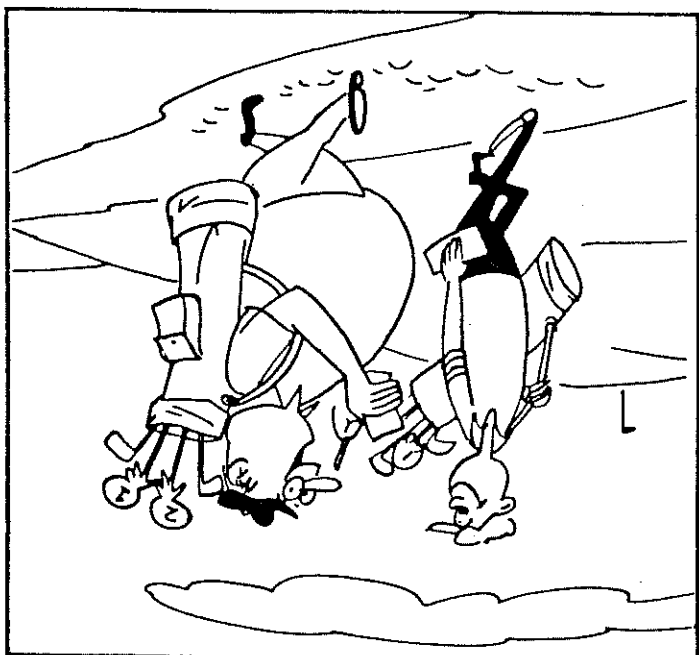

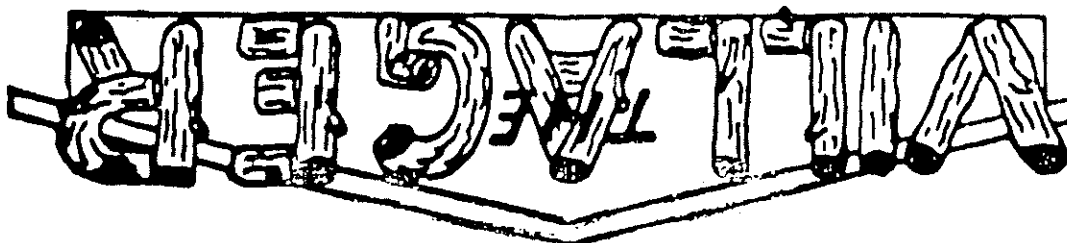

NEW YOUTH PROGRAM FOR VILLAGE

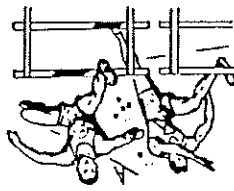

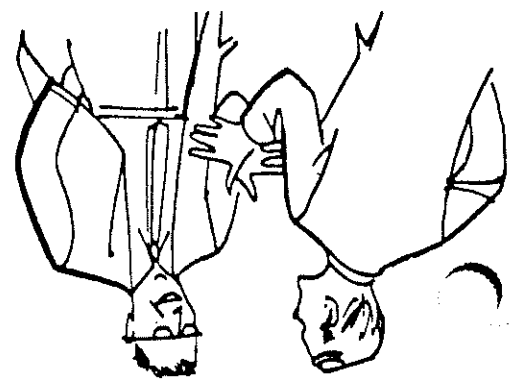
HEADLINE: "FATHER GORMAN

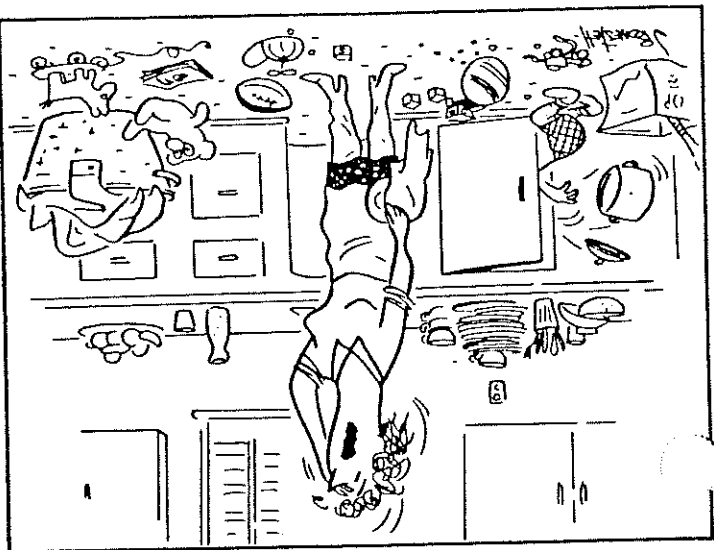
