## AN OPEN LETTER TO LVRA

IN SEVERAL OF THEIR LETTERS I'VE READ OF LOW MORALE DUE TO ROTTEN LETTERS FROM SO-CALLED RESPONSIBLE CITIZENS BACK HERE AND TO THE DEMONSTRATIONS, RIOTS AND OTHER INSTANCES OF BAD COOPERATION BY THE CITIZENRY. MY LETTERS WERE MERELY A SHEET OR TWO OF JOKES FROM PROFESSIONAL COMICS, CUT-OUT COMIC CARTOONS, PLUS CLARIFICATIONS OF THE CITIZENS TRUE ATTITUDE (WHICH OF COURSE IS SO MUCH BETTER THAN THEY HAD FEARED, OR MAYBE STILL EAR). THE RADIO I SENT TO ONE DEFENDER, COST ONLY ABOUT TEN DOLLARS; YET IT DID A LOT FOR THE MORALE OF A LOT OF GREAT GUYS.

WHAT ACTUALLY MAKES UP A DRUM AND BUGLE CORPS?

OUR NEW CORPS WILL HAVE A BRASS LINE OF VARIOUS TYPES OF BASS, FRENCH, AND SOPRANO HORNS. A DRUM LINE OF SNARES, TENORS, BASS, AND SYMBOLS. A COLOR GUARD TO CARRY THE NATIONAL, STATE, ORGANIZATIONAL, AND SPONSORS (IF ANY) COLORS, AND LAST BUT NOT LEAST A DRUM MAJOR.

YES, WE NEED ABOUT EIGHTY BOYS AND GIRLS WHOSE HEARTS WILL BEAT AS ONE WHEN THE SHRILLING BLASTS OF BUGLES AND CRISP THUMPING OF DRUMS BLEND IN A HARMONIC CHAMPIONSHIP TEMPO.

A CORPS USUALLY PRACTICES TO LEARN THEIR MUSIC AND DRILL DURING THE FALL AND WINTER. IN SPRING AND SUMMER THEY TRAVEL CALIFORNIA TO COMPETE WITH OTHER SUCH CORPS. THE DRUM AND BUGLE CORPS COULD BE ASSOCIATED WITH A BAND BUT ONLY IN NUMBERS. YOU SEE, A CORPS MUST BE JUDGED AT EVERY PERFORMANCE AND COULD LOSE A COMPETITION BY A TENTH OF A POINT.

TITLES ARE AT STAKE!

COOL BREEZES PLAY AGAINST NERVOUS, SWEAT-BEADED FACES OF THE FOLLOWERS IN THE STANDS. 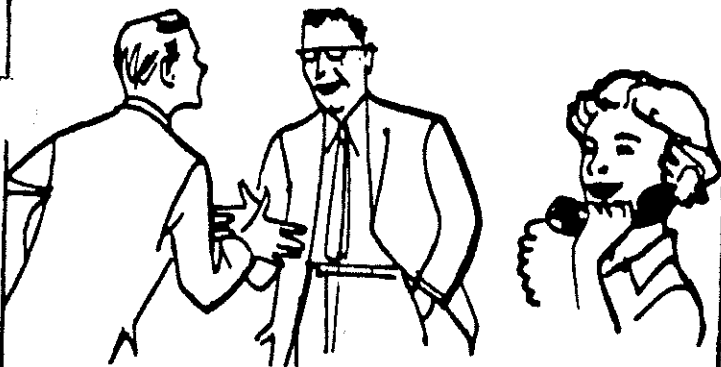
