THE NEXT LAKEWOOD VILLAGE RESIDENT'S ASSOCIATION GENERAL MEETING WILL HAVE ON THE AGENDA, AMONG OTHER THINGS, OUR ANNUAL ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND UNIT REPRESENTATIVES.

YOU HAVE PROBABLY ALREADY RECEIVED YOUR BALLOT IN THE MAIL - BE SURE TO USE IT! LAST YEAR APPROXIMATELY 30 MEMBER FAMILIES VOTED FROM OUR MEMBERSHIP OF OVER 100 FAMILIES. ALL MEMBERS OF A HOUSEHOLD OVER 18 ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE. IN SOME CASES OUR RECORDS DO NOT INDICATE IF THERE ARE MEMBERS OTHER THAN THE MAN AND WOMAN WHO ARE THE HEAD OF THE HOUSEHOLD, IF YOU RECEIVED ONLY 2 BALLOTS AND THERE ARE MORE MEMBERS IN YOUR FAMILY ELIGIBLE TO VOTE, THEY MAY PICK UP BALLOTS AT THE GENERAL MEETING.


- PRESIDENTS CORNER -

A NEW CITY ORDINANCE WILL GIVE PARENTS IN THE DETROIT SUBURB OF MADISON HEIGHTS LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR CRIMES COMMITTED BY THE MINOR CHILDREN.

IT PROVIDES THAT THE PARENTS OF A MINOR CHILD WHO COMMITS TWO OR MORE CRIMES IN A 12 MONTH PERIOD ARE SUBJECT TO A MAXIMUM PENALTY OF 90 DAYS IN JAIL AND A \$500.00 FINE.

EUGENE ARTHUR MOORE, OAKLAND COUNTY PROBATE COURT JUDGE, SAID THAT "IF THIS IS A WAY TO GET PARENTS TO FULFILL THEIR DUTY TO RAISE THEIR KIDS, IT'S FINE."

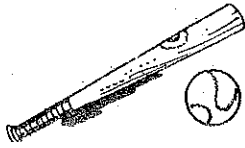

TO DATE APPROXIMATELY 260 BOYS HAVE SIGNED-UP FOR THIS SEASON. IT LOOKS LIKE THIS WILL BE ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL YEAR FOR OUR LEAGUE. IN CHECKING OVER LAST YEAR'S CARDS, OUR PLAYER-AGENT HAS COUNTED 180 PLAYERS FROM LAST YEAR WHO HAVE NOT SIGNED-UP YET. THESE BOYS ARE FROM MINORS, MAJORS AND SENIORS. PLANTING - DIG A HOLE TO FIT THE ROOTS, GENERALLY ABOUT 15 TO 18 INCHES IN DEPTH AND WIDTH. MAKE A CONE IN THE HOLE BOTTOM AND SPREAD ROOTS OVER IT. 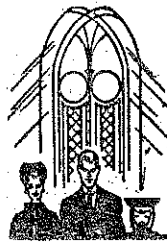

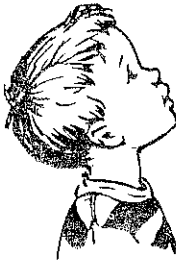

EPIC DRAMA RE-ENACTED

THE DRAMA OF HOLY WEEK AND EASTER CLIMAXES THE PERIOD OF PREPARATION CALLED LENT. CHRISTIANS AND OTHERS CAN BENEFIT FROM THE TRADITION WHICH MAKES THIS A SEASON OF SPIRITUAL RE-ORIENTATION.

HOLY WEEK BEGINS ON MARCH 22, PALM SUNDAY.

MARCH 26 IS MAUNDY THURSDAY; MARCH 27 IS GOOD FRIDAY, AND MARCH 29 IS EASTER.

PALM SUNDAY- ON THIS DAY JESUS ENTERED JERUSALEM, DURING THE DAYS OF PREPARATION FOR THE PASSOVER. HIS DISCIPLES AND MANY PEOPLE AMONG THE CROWDS CHEERED HIM AS THE MESSIAH. FOR MOST OF THEM IT WAS JUST WISHFUL THINKING. THEY WANTED A WARRIOR KING TO THROW OFF THE YOKE OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE. THE MESSIAH FOR WHOM THE JEWS PRAYED WAS TO BE A KING, BUT THE NATURE OF HIS KINGSHIP WAS OPEN TO MANY INTERPRETATIONS.

THE TITLE "MESSIAH" COMES FROM A HEBREW WORD CORRESPONDING TO THE WORD FOR "CHRIST" IN THE GREEK, THE WORD FROM WHICH WE GET "ANOINTED" IN THE LATIN, OR THE WORD "OILED" IN PLAIN ENGLISH. ALL THESE WORDS REFER TO THE CUSTOM OF PUTTING OIL ON THE HEAD OF A KING DURING HIS CORONATION.

JESUS INTERPRETED THE MESSIAH AS A SACRIFICIAL FIGURE, FOLLOWING THE PROPHECIES OF ISAIAH (CHAPTER 53) AND ZECHARIAH. ZECHARIAH ENVISIONED THE GREAT KING COMING HUMBLLY, LIKE A PEASANT RIDING ON A YOUNG DONKEY, AND JESUS ACTED THIS OUT AS HE ENTERED THE CITY. ZECHARIAH SAW THE TRIUMPH OF GOD AS COMING "NOT BY MIGHT AND NOT BY POWER, BUT BY MY SPIRIT, SAYS THE LORD." (ZECH. 4:6; 9:9-10)

MAUNDY THURSDAY- ON THIS NIGHT, JESUS ATE HIS LAST SUPPER WITH HIS DISCIPLES IN AN UPPER ROOM IN JERUSALEM. MANY CHURCHES CELEBRATE HOLY COMMUNION ON THIS DAY IN MEMORY OF THE ONE WHO GAVE HIS LIFE FOR US, SYMBOLISING THIS IN ADVANCE BY THE BREAD AND WINE WHICH THEY CONSUMED.

MAUDY THURSDAY IS NAMED FROM THE GREAT "COMMAUNDMENT" WHICH JESUS GAVE AFTER HE HAD HUMBLLY WASHED THE DISCIPLES' FEET, "LOVE ONE ANOTHER, EVEN AS I HAVE LOVED YOU."

GOOD FRIDAY- JESUS DIED UPON A CROSS, AN INSTRUMENT OF EXECUTION FOR THE MOST DANGEROUS CRIMINALS. CHRISTIANS SEE IN THIS THE SUPREME REVELATION OF THE WICKEDNESS TO WHICH MEN MAY STOOP AND THE OUTREACHING AND SACRIFICIAL LOVE OF GOD, WHO GOES EVEN TO THIS EXTREME IN TRYING TO REACH US AND CHANGE OUR SINFUL HEARTS.



EASTER- THE "LAST ACT OF THE DRAMA," GIVES US THE ASSURANCE OF THE TRIUMPH OF REAL LIFE IN JESUS CHRIST, WHO WAS FAITHFUL UNTO DEATH AND WHO ROSE FROM THE GRAVE IN VINDICATION OF HIS WAY OF LIFE. HIS VICTORY FORTIFIES US TO BELIEVE THAT EVEN NOW HE CAN LIFT US FROM DEATH INTO LIFE BY THE POWER OF HIS SPIRIT. EASTER IS THE DAY OF TRIUMPH FOR LIFE OVER DEATH IN US.

HOLY WEEK HAS A UNIVERSAL MESSAGE. IT RE-ENACTS AN EPIC DRAMA WHICH TOUCHES THE BASIC REALITIES OF EVERY HUMAN LIFE AT MANY POINTS. IT IS ALWAYS AN ENRICHING EXPERIENCE TO RE-LIVE IT AND TO RECEIVE AGAIN ITS DEEP TRUTHS INTO OUR SOULS.
