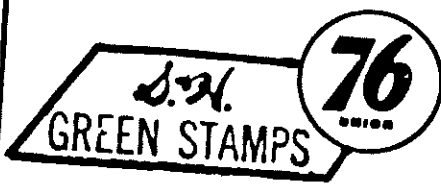
TROOP 67, WENT ON A TOUR OF THE PACIFIC
