A WARNING ON RABIES WAS ISSUED TODAY TO SUMMER VACATIONISTS BY DR GEORGE MARTIN, SANTA CLARA COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT VETERINARIAN, FOLLOWING THE DISCOVERY THAT A FOUR YEAR OLD BOY FROM THIS COUNTY HAD BEEN BITTEN BY A RABID BAT DURING A NORTHERN CALIFORNIA VACATION EARLY THIS MONTH.

DR MARTIN STATED THAT THE CHILD BEGAN RECEIVING THE PASTEUR TREATMENT IMMEDIATELY AFTER LABORATORY EXAMINATION PROVED THE BAT TO BE INFECTED WITH THIS EXTREMELY SERIOUS DISEASE. THE BAT WAS CAPTURED BY THE BOY'S PARENTS SHORTLY AFTER IT HAD ATTACKED THE SLEEPING CHILD IN THE BEDROOM OF A SUMMER CABIN.

IN ISSUING THE WARNING, HE ALSO POINTED OUT THAT SANTA CLARA COUNTY ITSELF IS A RABIES ENDEMIC AREA WHICH MEANS THAT WILDLIFE IN THE COUNTY HAVE BEEN FOUND TO BE INFECTED WITH RABIES.

DR MARTIN STRESSED THAT WHILE ONE CASE OF RABIES DOES NOT MEAN THAT ALL OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES MUST BE CURTAILED, IT IS WISE FOR CHILDREN AND PARENTS TO BE AWARE OF CERTAIN PRECAUTIONS WHICH SHOULD BE TAKEN:

1. DO NOT PET STRAY ANIMALS.
 2. DO NOT APPROACH WILD ANIMALS THAT APPEAR TO BE TAME.
 3. DO NOT HANDLE WILD ANIMALS.
 4. DO NOT HANDLE SICK ANIMALS.
 5. BE SURE YOUR OWN DOGS AND CATS HAVE ANTI RABIES VACCINE EVERY TWO YEARS.
 6. PARTICULAR ATTENTION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO BATS AS THEY ARE A KNOWN SOURCE OF RABIES. BATS ARE NOCTURNAL ANIMALS AND, IF SEEN MOVING ABOUT IN DAYTIME, THEY HAVE EITHER BEEN DISTURBED OR ARE ABNORMAL IN SOME WAY. STAY AWAY FROM THEM.
 7. REPORT ALL ANIMAL BITES TO THE NEAREST HEALTH DEPARTMENT OR SHERIFF'S OFFICE.
- BY OBSERVING THESE PRECAUTIONS, THE NECESSITY OF TAKING THE PASTEUR TREATMENT, WHICH IS PAINFUL AND NOT WITHOUT SOME DANGER, MAY BE AVOIDED, HE ADDED.

IF A PERSON IS BITTEN THE WOUND SHOULD BE WASHED THOROUGHLY WITH SOAP AND WATER AND A PHYSICIAN SEEN IMMEDIATELY. EVERY EFFORT SHOULD BE MADE TO SEE THAT THE ANIMAL IS IMPOUNDED. IF IT IS A STRAY OR WILD ANIMAL IT MUST BE DESTROYED, IT SHOULD NOT BE SHOT THROUGH THE HEAD AS IT IS NECESSARY FOR THE BRAIN TO BE PRESERVED FOR EXAMINATION BY A HEALTH DEPARTMENT LABORATORY IN ORDER TO MAKE A DIAGNOSIS.

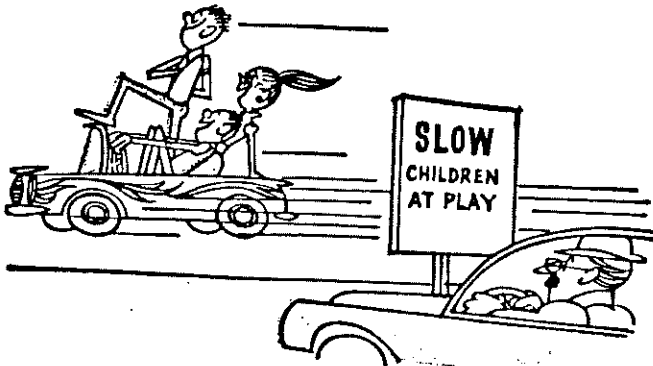

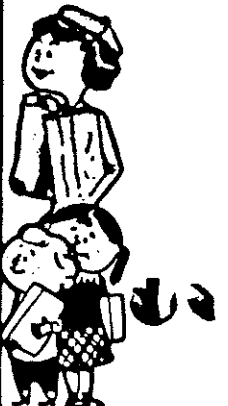

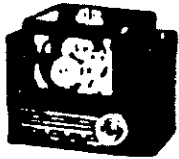
