## Teens Have Success

## L.V.R.A. MEETING AUGUST 6,

JIM RAYMOND FROM THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT WAS AMONG THE GUESTS, TELLING ABOUT THE PLANS OF THE LAKEWOOD TEENS AND THANKING EVERYONE WHO ASSISTED IN GIVING TRANSPORTATION FOR THEIR ACTIVITIES. HE ALSO THANKED THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE REFRESHMENTS DONATED. JIM SAID FROM 45 TO 65 TEENS WERE ATTENDING EVERY WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY AND WERE VERY ENTHUSIASTIC.

HE TOLD OF THE AUCTION COMING AUGUST 10, AT 6 P.M. AT THE FAIRWOOD SCHOOL WHERE THE KIDS WOULD AUCTION OFF THEIR LABOR FOR TWO OR THREE HOURS AT A MINIMUM OF 25¢ AN HOUR, TO SPONSOR A HAYRIDE, BARBECUE AND DANCE SCHEDULED AUGUST 25. HE SAID MOST OF THE MERCHANTS FROM LAKEWOOD SHOPPING CENTER WOULD ATTEND, AND URGED ALL L.V.R.A. MEMBERS BE PRESENT. THE KIDS HAVE ALSO RAISED \$20 FROM A BOTTLE DRIVE WHICH WILL BE PUT INTO THE FUND.

THE L.V.R.A. ASKED RAYMOND IF THE PROGRA WOULD CONTINUE THROUGH THE FALL. HE EXPLAIN THAT DUE TO LACK OF FUNDS AND A BUILDING, THE PROGRAM WOULD HAVE TO BE DISCONTINUED UNTIL NEXT YEAR WHEN THE LAKEWOOD PARK WOULD BE FINISHED, THEN A YEAR ROUND PROGRA WOULD BE SET UP. THIS REPORTER WOULD LIKE TO COMMEND JIM RAYMOND & KATHERINE PARKER FOR THE FINE WORK THEY HAVE DONE WITH OUR TEENS

ALSO AS GUEST SPEAKER WAS LEE PORTER REPRESENTING A COMMITTEE ON FLUORIDATION FOR SUNNYVALE, HE EXPLAINED WHAT IT WAS, WHAT I WOULD DO FOR OUR CHILDREN AND WHY SOME PEOPLE WERE AGAINST IT. SINCE THE COMMITTEE WAS GOING TO CITY COUNCIL THE FOLLOWING NIGHT, PORTER ASKED THE L.V.R.A. TO ENDORSE THE PROPOSAL TO BE PUT ON THE NOV. BALLOT. IT WAS PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

RON SCHWARTZ REPORTED ON THE SCHOOL BOARD AND DUE TO THE OVER CROWDEDNESS OF FAIRWOOD SCHOOL, THREE CLASSES WILL BE RESERVED AT BISHOP SCHOOL UNTIL THE PORTABLES ARE FINISHED AT FAIRWOOD. MRS. ANN KELLY ALSO SAID THAT THERE WOULD'NT BE ANY CLASSES NEXT YEAR FOR RETARDED AND ADVANCED STUDENTS DUE TO A LACK OF STATE FUNDS AND ASKED THAT WE WRITE REP. CHARLES S. GUBSER ASKING THAT THIS BE CARRIED OUT NEXT YEAR.

DICK LOFTON REPORTED THAT THERE WERE 52 NEW MEMBERS THIS MONTH.

L.V.R.A. TALKS TO NEW ASSOCIATION

MR. DICK LOFTON THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN FOR THE L.V.R.A. WAS ASKED TO SPEAK ON BEHALF OF THE ASSOCIATION, TO THE NEWLY ORGANIZED LOS GATOS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION WHO IS JUST GETTING STARTED. HE WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MR. FRANCIS MICK AND MYSELF.

MR. LOFTON STARTED BY SHOWING THE NEW ASSOCIATION THE "VILLAGER", TELLING HOW IT GOT THE NEWS TO THE PEOPLE WHO COULDN'T ATTEND THE MEETINGS. HE EXPLAINED THAT THE L.V.R.A. WAS ORGANIZED IN 1957, GOT ITS CHARTER IN EARLY 1958 AND HAS GROWN TO BE THE LARGEST RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA WITH ITS 1200 MEMBERS.

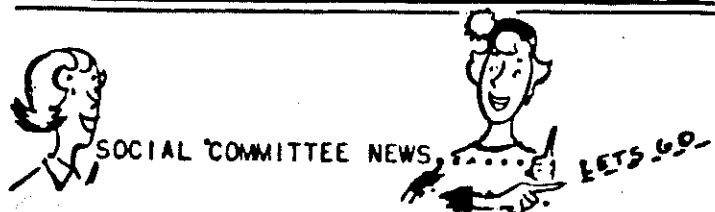

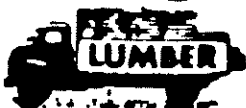

STUDENTS AND TEACHERS FROM THREE CLASS ROOMS AT FAIRWOOD SCHOOL FIND THEMSELVES AT BISHOP UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF THREE PORTABLE CLASSROOMS. DR. GLEN WIRT, ASST. SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, SUNNYVALE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT, STATED THAT THE DISTRICT HAS RECEIVED AUTHORITY TO LET THE BIDS FOR THE PORTABLES. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT CONSTRUCTION WILL COMMENCE IN SEPTEMBER, AND HOPE THAT THE CHILDREN WILL BE ABLE TO MOVE BACK TO FAIRWOOD AFTER THE CHRISTMAS VACATION.

AT THE BOARD'S MEETING OF 8-2-62, THE BUDGET FOR 62-63 WAS SET AT \$4,679,619.13.
