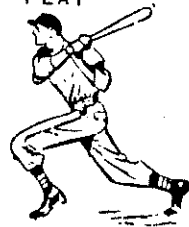

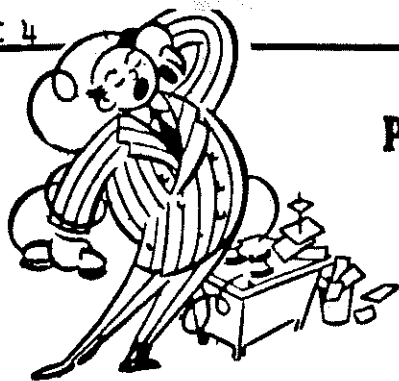

ON THEMSELVES TO USE THE SWIMMING POOL AND COMMIT OTHER ACTS THAT ARE NOT IN GOOD TASTE OR RESPECT. SOME YOUNGSTERS HAVE BEEN OBSERVED DRINKING SOFTDRINKS & THEN THROW THE BOTTLES IN THE AIR FOR IT TO FALL ONTO THE STREETS, TO BREAK AND CAUSE A LOT OF DAMAGE. THE BRIGHTER SIDE OF ALL THIS IS THE TROUBLE IS CAUSED BY LESS THAN A DOZEN YOUNGSTERS. SCHOOL PROGRAM

SUMMER SCHOOL ENDED. THE TWO SUMMER SCHOOL CENTERS IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE HELD THEIR OPEN HOUSE ON JULY 23RD, AND FORMALLY ENDED THE FOUR WEEK SESSION AUGUST 2ND. THE DISTRICT SOUGHT TO SERVE THE CHILDREN ON BOTH SIDES OF LAWRENCE STATION ROAD BY HOLDING SESSIONS AT LAKEWOOD AND FAIRWOOD SCHOOLS. ALTHOUGH THE ATTENDANCE AT THE SESSIONS WAS BELOW EXPECTATIONS (109 AT LAKEWOOD AND 111 AT FAIRWOOD) MISS HAZEL HOAK, PRINCIPAL AT FAIRWOOD, STATED THAT YOUNG PEOPLE WERE INTERESTED AND REALLY LIKED TO LEARN. MR HALEY, PRINCIPAL AT LAKEWOOD, FELT THAT THE MAJORITY OF THE CHILDREN ATTENDED TO KEEP THEIR SKILLS SHARP AND TO ENRICH AND BROADEN THEIR LEARNING EXPERIENCES.

A BIG THANKS TO MISS HOAK, MR HALEY, AND THEIR STAFFS FOR KEEPING THE MINDS OF OUR CHILDREN STIMULATED THROUGH THE SUMMER.

BUDGET PASSED. BY THIS TIME IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE 1963-64 SCHOOL BUDGET WAS ADOPTED AT THE PUBLIC HEARING ON AUGUST 1ST. DR GLEN WIRT, ASST SUPT - BUSINESS, ANNOUNCED WITH PLEASURE THAT THE COUNTY INCREASED ITS ASSESSED VALUATION OVER LAST YEAR BY \$14 MILLION.
