THIS IS THE FOURTH YEAR

THIS MONTH IS THE FOURTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SUNNYVALE PUBLIC LIBRARY. IF YOU ARE NOT FAMILIAR WITH THE LOCATION, YOU MAY REACH IT VIA MATHILDA TO OLIVE. IT IS JUST BEHIND THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT.

MR. COLIN LUCAS IS THE CITY LIBRARIAN. THE LIBRARY IS STAFFED BY SIX PROFESSIONAL LIBRARIANS, WITH OPENINGS FOR TWO MORE, AND ELEVEN CLERKS.

THE HOURS ARE FROM 10 TO 9 WEEK-DAYS AND FROM 9 TO 6 ON SATURDAYS. THE LIBRARY CURRENTLY HOUSES 82000 BOOKS AND HAS AN ANNUAL CIRCULATION OF 500,000. THERE ARE 36,000 REGISTERED CARD HOLDERS AT THE PRESENT TIME, WITH 30,000 ANTICIPATED BY THE END OF THE YEAR.

ADULTS MAY OBTAIN LIBRARY CARDS IMMEDIATELY BY MERELY PRESENTING PROOF OF RESIDENCE. NO REFERENCES ARE REQUIRED. CHILDREN MAY OBTAIN CARDS WITH THE PARENTS SIGNATURE AND IDENTIFICATION OF SOME SORT. THERE IS A TWO WEEK LOAN PERIOD ON MOST BOOKS AND YOU MAY CHECK OUT UP TO TEN BOOKS AT ONE TIME.

THE LIBRARY HAS APPROXIMATELY 300 CURRENT MAGAZINES ON HAND AND A WIDE SELECTION OF PAMPHLETS AND DOCUMENTS ON CURRENT INFORMATION AND REFERENCE MATERIAL THAT MAY BE CIRCULATED OR CHECKED OUT, IF NECESSARY.

THERE IS A NICE COLLECTION OF BOOKS ON CALIFORNIA HISTORY, HOUSED IN A SEPERATE ROOM THERE IS A WIDE SELECTION OF VOCATIONAL COLLEGE CATALOGUES AND TELEPHONE DIRECTORIES FROM PRACTICALLY ALL MAJOR CITIES.

FOR THOSE INTERESTED IN ARTS, THERE IS A SPECIAL SECTION OF ART REFERENCE AND VOCATIONAL TYPE BOOKS. THERE IS A SPECIAL COLLECTION OF PLAYS AND SKITS ALSO.

IN THE CHILDRENS SECTION YOU WILL FIND A WIDE SELECTION OF BOOKS FOR THE YOUNGER SET WITH A SPECIAL COLLECTION OF BOOKS DESIGNED

ESPECIALLY FOR PRE-SCHOOLERS, KINDERGARTNERS OR CHILDREN WITH READING DIFFICULTIES. THERE IS A STORY HOUR EVERY SAYURDAY AT 11 AM. FOR THE ELEMENTARY STUDENTS AND ONE ON THURSDAYS AT 10 AM. FOR PRE-SCHOOLERS.

A SMALL MEETING ROOM IS AVAILABLE TO GROUPS OR ORGANIZATIONS FOR LIBRARY RELATED PROGRAMS.

THERE ARE TWO PHOTOCOPY MACHINES, ONE FOR DUPLICATING LIBRARY METERIALS AND A COIN OPERATED ONE FOR DUPLICATING YOUR PERSONAL DOCUMENTS.

DONATIONS OF BOOKS ARE GRATEFULLY ACCEPTED, & WILL BE PLACED, IF POSSIBLE IN LOCAL LIBRARY. BEFORE PURCHASING A BOOK FOR A DONATION, HOWEVER, YOU SHOULD CONSULT THE LIBRARY TO AVOID DUPLICATION. BACK ISSUES OF MAGAZINES IN GOOD CONDITION ARE ALSO WELCOMED.

RECOMMENDATIONS OR SUGGESTIONS ARE ALSO APPRECIATED. WHY NOT PLAN ON TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE WONDERFUL WEALTH OF INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO YOU AT OUR PUBLIC LIBRARY? I PROMISE YOU WILL BE IMPRESSED WITH THE PROGRESS THEY HAVE MADE IN THESE PAST FOUR YEARS AND WILL LOOK FORWARD TO, AS I AM TO THE FUTURE EXPANSION OF OUR CITY LIBRARY. WHEN THE BAD SECTION IS SAWED OUT; REPLACE THE BOARD WITH A FINISHED ONE. AN UNFINISHED ONE IS CHEAPER BUT WON'T FIT WELL. (OVER-SIZED)

THE ROOFING PAPER HAS TORN AWAY FROM THE TRIM AT THE EDGES AND WILL NOT STOP THE RAIN, FROM ENTERING THE WALLS. MY SOLUTION IS TO

REMOVE THE GRAVEL AWAY FROM THE EDGES ABOUT A FOOT AND A HALF AND CUT OUT THE DAMAGED TAR PAPER. TAKING A 24" ROLL OF TAR PAPER I'LL TACK IT DOWN ON TOP OF TRIM AND LET PAPER CURVE TO ROOF. THEN TAR OR USE ROOFING SEAL. REGRAVEL AND HOPE I'LL STAY DRY.

STUCCO HAS SHOWN SOME CRACKS THAT INVITE BUGS & FURTHER TROUBLE. USE A SEALANT.

PERHAPS I'VE GOT THE ONLY HOME WITH PROBLEMS; BUT I HOPE TO KEEP THEM SMALL ONES. IT COSTS A LOT MORE TO FIX A LARGE ONE.

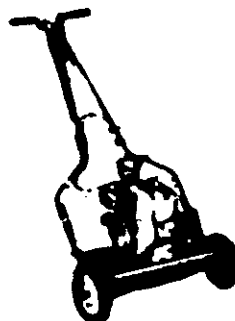
