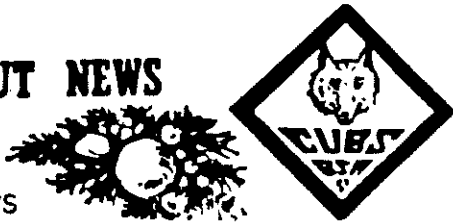

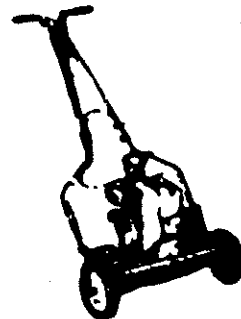

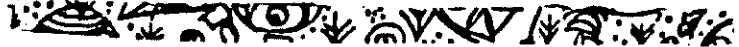

WAIT TIL SPRING TO PRUNE TENDER PLANTS. P.S. TULIPS, RANUNCULAS, ANEMONES & HYACINTHS CAN STILL BE PLANTED BUT HURRY.

ROSES: THIS LOVELY FLOWER CAN BE DISCUSSED

COMPLETELY IF YOU HAVE A COUPLE OF EXTRA DAYS TO READ ABOUT THEM. SO I'M GOING TO TRY TO GIVE YOU A COUPLE OF POINTERS.

RULE ONE; BUY HEALTHY PLANTS; GRADE #1. THESE "SPECIALS" ON SALE WILL OFTEN BE A GREAT DISAPPOINTMENT COME LATE SUMMER.

RULE TWO: LOCATE & PLANT PROPERLY. IN THIS AREA, PLANTING YOUR ROSES IN FULL SUN & AGAINST A WALL (FOR REFLECTIVE HEAT) WILL DISCOURAGE MILDEW. BUY ROSES WITH FEW PETALES AS THESE OPEN READILY IN COOL WEATHER. PASTEL COLORS ARE RECOMMENDED; AS DEEP TONES TEND TO GET CLOUDY. WHITE ROSES HAVE A TENDANCY TO "BALL UP" IN OUR FOGGY WEATHER. REDS & PINKS WILL MILDEW EASILY.

RULE THREE: SUPPLY YOUR ROSES WITH FOUR BASIC NEEDS; DEEP WATERING, SMALL AMOUNTS OF FERTILIZER REGULARLY (STARTING AFTER THE PLANT IS PAST ITS FIRST YEARS GROWTH), PRUNE CONSERVATIVELY, AND (THE BIGGEST JOB) CONTROL PESTS & DISEASES.
