1. NOTE--DUE TO THE NATURE OF OUR PROGRAM IT IS NECESSARY TO START OUR GENERAL MEETING AT 7:00 P.M. WE WANT ALL BOARD MEMBERS AND REPS. AND ALL INTERESTED PEOPLE TO BE THERE AT 7:00 P.M. ONE VERY IMPORTANT ITEM IS THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE WILL TAKE CARE OF THEIR BUSINESS, IN REGARDS TO NEW OFFICERS WHICH ARE ELECTED IN MARCH.

AT 7:40 WE SHALL INTRODUCE OUR GUEST SPEAKERS ON THE ISSUE OF SCHOOL UNIFICATION.

THE SUNNYVALE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE FREMONT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, BECOME A UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT INCLUDING ESTABLISHMENT OF A SEVEN MEMBER GOVERNING BOARD ELECTED AT LARGE AND INCLUDING AUTHORIZATION OF A TAX VOTE AT THE MAXIMUM RATE ALLOWABLE BY LAW AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 3255 OF THE EDUCATION CODE?"

BY THE TIME YOU READ THIS YOU MAY HAVE RECEIVED YOUR SAMPLE BALLOT, IF NOT, YOU WILL IN A FEW DAYS.

BECAUSE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF THIS QUESTION TO YOU AS PARENTS AND TAXPAYERS THE LVRA HAS SCHEDULED A PANEL DISCUSSION OF THIS QUESTION AT OUR FEB. 1ST. MEETING.

ON THE PANEL WILL BE MR. IVAN MEYERHOLTZ OF CUPERTINO. MR. MEYERHOLTZ WAS BORN IN CUPERTINO AND ATTENDED LOCAL SCHOOLS. HE WENT TO STANFORD. HE SERVED 30 YRS, ON THE CUPERTINO BOARD OF EDUCATION, 21 OF WHICH HE WAS CHAIRMAN. HE SERVED 14 YRS. ON THE COUNTY

COMMITTEE FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT REORGANIZATION.

MR. LEE BROWN OF CUPERTINO, AND A PAST MEMBER OF THE CITIZENS COMMITTEE ON THE QUESTION OF UNIFICATION OF THESE DISTRICTS AND AT PRESENT, CHAIRMAN OF A COMMITTEE THAT HAS BEEN DOING FURTHER STUDIES ON THIS.

MR. AL OSLIN OF SUNNYVALE, PAST CO PRESIDENT WITH HIS WIFE OF DE ANZA P.T.A. AND A FORMER MEMBER OF THE CITIZENS COMMITTEE THAT STUDIED THIS QUESTION.

DR. JOHN BORDEAUX (PH D.) OF SUNNYVALE WILL BE THE FOURTH SPEAKER. MR. BORDEAUX WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE CITIZENS COMMITTEE MENTIONED ABOVE. HE HAS ALSO BEEN A CANDIDATE FOR THE SUNNYVALE BOARD OF EDUCATION. HE SAID THAT IF HE IS UNABLE TO ATTEND HE WILL HAVE SOME ONE IN HIS PLACE.

ASSOCIATION REQUESTS FIRE INVESTIGATION

A FIRE AT THE PATRICK MOORE HOME AT 238 TORRANCE ON DECEMBER 20TH RESULTED IN THE ASSOCIATION REQUESTING AN INVESTIGATION INTO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT. MANY NEIGHBORS AND RESIDENTS COMPLAINED THAT THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT DID NOT RENDER AID PROPERLY TO MR. MOORE, WHO WAS INJURED. THEY FURTHER COMPLAINED THAT THEY HAD MUCH DIFFICULTY CONTACTING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THAT THE FIREMEN DID NOT PUT THEIR EQUIPMENT INTO SERVICE FOR SOME TIME AFTER ARRIVING ON THE SCENE.

THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT CONDUCTED AN INVESTIGATION AND FOUND THAT AN AMBULANCE WAS NOT CALLED FOR SEVERAL MINUTES AFTER THE FIREMEN ARRIVED. THEIR INVESTIGATION ALSO REVEALED THAT ONE ENGINE ARRIVED ON THE SCENE 5 MINUTES AFTER THEY WERE NOTIFIED. A SECOND ENGINE ARRIVED ONE MINUTE LATER. THEIR REPORT REVEALS THAT THEY DID NOT HOOK UP THE FIRE ENGINE TO THE FIRE PLUG FOR 9 MINUTES AFTER THE FIRST ENGINE ARRIVED AND 8 MINUTES AFTER THE SECOND ENGINE ARRIVED ON THE SCENE.

THE HOUSE AND CONTENTS WERE A COMPLETE

LOSS. MR. MOORE SUFFERED A SEVERED ARTERY IN TWO PLACES TO HIS LEFT ARM.

THE ASSOCIATION REQUESTED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL ORDER AN INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE THE FOLLOWING:

IS THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT PROPERLY TRAINED

ARE THEY PROPERLY STAFFED

WOULD SEPERATE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS BE BENEFICIAL TO THE CITY

WOULD FIRE CALL BOXES BE HELPFUL

WOULD A RESCUE VEHICLE BE FEASIBLE

THE COUNCIL DID NOT APPROVE OF THE INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION, HOWEVER, THEY DID ORDER AN INVESTIGATION BY THE FIRE UNDERWRITERS. THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE IS RATED A CLASS 5 BY THE UNDERWRITERS AND ALL NEIGHBORING CITIES ARE RATED A CLASS 3. SHOULD SUNNYVALE BE RATED CLASS 3, THE FIRE INSURANCE RATES WOULD DROP. THE COUNCIL INDICATED THAT IF THE UNDERWRITERS RATING DOES NOT CHANGE THE RATING THEY WILL TAKE ANOTHER LOOK.

LOSS OF THE MOORE HOME WAS NOT THE FIRST IN THE VILLAGE. WE HAVE HAD SEVERAL SEVERE FIRES IN THE PAST 18 MONTHS.

NOW IS THE TIME TO PLANT ROOTS OR DIVISIONS OF PERENNIAL VEGETABLES. SOME ANNUALS CAN BE PLANTED IF NURSERY STARTED. SUMMER BULBS CAN BE PLACED SUCH AS TUBEROUS BEGONIAS, GLOXINIAS, AND STREPTOCARPUS, IF SHELTERED. WE'RE STILL APT TO GET SOME FROST.

COMPLETE YOUR BARE-ROOT PLANTING. ALMOST ALL YOUR NURSERIES HAVE ROSES (PATENT & NON-PATENT), FRUIT TREES AND SHADE TREES ON SALE. REMEMBER, BARGAINS DON'T ALWAYS MEAN GOOD BUYS IN GARDENING.

IF YOU THINK THE HEAVY FROST IS OVER, YOU CAN START YOUR HARDIER VEGETABLES IN OPEN GROUND. SUMMER ANNUALS AND TENDER VEGETABLES ARE BEST STARTED IN FLATS UNDER PROTECTION.

PRUNE YOUR FRUIT TREES BEFORE LEAF AND FLOWER BUDS OPEN. SPRAY THE PRUNED TREES IMMEDIATELY WITH A DORMENT SPRAY. PEACH TREES, ESPECIALLY, NEED PROTECTION AGAINST LEAF CURL. FUCHSIAS NEED TO BE PRUNED BACK 2/3' RDS AT THE END OF THE MONTH WHEN ALL DANGER OF FROST IS GONE. HYBRID TEA ROSES SHOULD BE PRUNED AT THE SAME TIME.

BARE-ROOT ROSES: LOOK AROUND YOUR HOME TODAY, AND PLAN WHERE YOU WANT THESE FRAGRANT BEAUTIES. REMEMBER THERE ARE VARIOUS ROSES TO FIT VARIOUS LANDSCAPES.

BUSH HYBRID TEA ROSES ARE MEANT TO BE GROWN TOGETHER IN A SECTION OF YOUR GARDEN. RESERVED AS "THE ROSE GARDEN!" PLAN TO POSITION YOUR ROSES ON 2½ TO 3 FOOT CENTERS. BE SURE TO SELECT A SITE IN FULL SUNLIGHT AND GOOD CIRCULATION OF AIR. MIX YOUR COLORS SO THAT IT WILL BE EASY TO PICK A BEAUTIFUL BOUQUET.

IF YOU WISH TO USE THE MORE ROBUST GRAND IFLORA VARIETIES, PLACE THEM BEHIND THE HYBRID TEAS AND CENTER THEM ON 4 FOOT CIRCLES.

THE FLORIBUNDA GROUP ARE BEST UTILIZED AS 2 TO 5 FOOT HEDGES, EXCELLENT GARDEN DIVIDERS AND USEFUL FENCE "SOFTERERS".

TRY LINING YOUR WALKS WITH TREE ROSES. OR PLACE THEM IN CONTAINERS ABOUT YOUR PATIO. THE NICE THING ABOUT TREE ROSES IS IT BRINGS THE FLOWERS TO EYE AND NOSE LEVEL, THUS ENHANCING THE ENJOYMENT OF YOUR FAVORITE VARIETIES.

A VERY FRIENDLY REQUEST,
FOR LIBERTY AND KIDS

FELLOW AMERICANS:

I AM RESIGNING FROM LVRA. NOT WITH PREJUDICE; I GREATLY ENJOYED THE ASSOCIATIONS, AND THE CHANCE TO DO SOMETHING WHEN SOMETHING NEEDED THE DOING. I JUST FEEL NOW THAT MY EFFORTS FOR THE COMMUNITY AND COUNTRY CAN BEST BE DIRECTED THRU OTHER CHANNELS. BUT BEFORE THAT HAPPENS, I REQUEST THE CHANCE TO MAKE ONE MORE SUCH CITIZEN EFFORT, DOING SO VIA LVRA NEWSPAPER. THE EFFORT IS ANOTHER "LET'S WAKE UP AND OPERATE OUR GOVERNMENT FOR DEFENSE AND VICTORY" TRY, SUCH AS THE MANY I MADE AFTER READING HOMER LEE'S BOOK, "THE VALOR OF IGNORANCE", IN 1937. WRITTEN ABOUT SEVENTY YEARS AGO BY A GREAT MILITARY MIND, AND APPROVED BY THE LEADERS OF GERMANY, OTHER LANDS, AND OUR ARMY CHIEF OF STAFF, GENERAL CHAFFEE, IT STATED THAT THE JAPANESE WERE DEFINITELY GOING TO JUMP THIS COUNTRY. IT ALSO PROVIDED PSYCHOLOGICAL PROOF OF HIS ASSERTION THAT THEY WOULD FIND US UNREADY. HIS MAIN REASON FOR THE UNREADINESS BEING "THE VALOR OF IGNORANCE", BORN OF THE SUPERMAN MYTH, ETC.

NOT SO LONG AGO, OUR DOLLAR WAS TOTTERING. OUR GOVERNMENT SHORED UP THE POOR, TIRED THING JUST IN TIME, BY A WORLD BANK LOAN. SUCH LOANS CANNOT GO ON DOING SO FOREVER.

THE COMMUNISTS EXPECT, WITH MUCH CAUSE, THAT WE WILL "BURY" OURSELVES THRU SUCH IDIOTICIES AS, SPENDING OURSELVES OUT OF MILITARY EXISTENCE.

WHEN KENNEDY WAS CAMPAIGNING FOR THE PRESIDENCY I WROTE THE GOVERNMENT A REQUEST THAT IT ADOPT A SPECIAL TAX, EITHER NEW OR ALREADY ON THE BOOKS, FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF MAKING PAYMENTS ON OUR NATIONAL DEBT. ECONOMY AS TO PERMIT OF FAR LOWER PRICES THAT WOULD ENABLE US TO COMPETE ABROAD; THIS TO BE DONE BY SUCH MEANS AS IMPOSITION OF PRICE CONTROLS ON INDUSTRY, AND WAGE CONTROLS ON LABOR, WITHIN A PLAN THAT NEITHER OF THOSE PARTIES COULD REASONABLY ACCUSE OF BEING PLANNED TO UNFAIRLY BENEFIT THE OTHER. IF THE REQUEST HAD BEEN SIGNED BY A PUBLIC MAJORITY INSTEAD OF LONE ME, IT COULD AT WORST HAVE MADE SURE OF SOME VERY HELPFUL CHANGES. I HOPE MY FELLOW CITIZENS WILL SOON JOIN ME IN REPETITION OF THOSE REQUESTS. ALSO THAT THEY WILL REMAIN DYNAMICALLY CITIZEN, DYNAMICALLY PROTECTIVE OF COUNTRY AND KIDS, BY CONTINUING TO STRUGGLE FOR WHATEVER CHANGES MUST BE MADE SO THAT WE CAN HAVE A PROPER CHANCE TO WIN THIS WAR INSTEAD OF CONTINUALLY VIEWING THE ENEMY'S ADVANCE. HEAVY EMPHASIS GOES ON THE WORD, KIDS. HELPLESSLY IN NEED OF OUR PROTECTION. THEY HAVE FULL RIGHT TO ALL OF IT WE CAN POSSIBLY RENDER, REGARDLESS OF THE OBSTACLES WE MUST ELIMINATE AND THE BOTHER OF THE JOB.

I HAVE THE CHILDREN IN MIND VERY ESPECIALLY, BECAUSE IF WE DELIBERATELY REJECT THE CHANCE TO PROTECT THEM, AS THE GIGANTIC MAJORITY DID PRIOR TO PEARL HARBOR (THE FIRST ONE), WE WILL BE GUILTY OF A SUPREMELY HEINOUS OFFENSE. THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO DID SO BEFORE PEARL HARBOR, HAD AT LEAST SOME EXCUSE IN IGNORANCE, EVEN THOUGH THAT IGNORANCE HAD BEEN AVOIDABLE; WE WOULD NOT HAVE ANY EXCUSE WHATEVER.

I REQUEST THAT WE ADOPT SUCH A "WAKE UP AND GET MOVING" PROGRAM IN A HURRY, AND WITH CAREFUL THOUGHT, LEST WE SOMEDAY FIND THE KIDS GOING TO COMMIE TRAINING SCHOOLS, AND OURSELVES REQUIRING SHEER GUMPTION OF SELF-DISHONESTY SO AS TO LOOK THEM IN THE EYES.

INSUFFLATION (Rescue Breathing)

When a person cannot breath for himself due to electric shock, gas asphyxiation or drowning, you may preserve a life if you do the following at once:

1. If Air Passage Is Blocked, clear at once by striking victim sharply on back, by dislodging the obstruction with your fingers, or by drawing it out by suction.
2. Start Insufflation immediately — The first several seconds are vitally important. Do not delay resuscitation to summon doctor or aid, transport victim or give secondary first aid.
3. Place Victim on His Back with neck fully extended (head back). A coat or pillow placed beneath his shoulders will help maintain this position.
4. Elevate Victim's Jaw by inserting your thumb between his teeth, grasping the lower jaw and lifting it forcefully upward until the lower teeth are higher than the upper teeth.
5. Close Victim's Nose by pinching the nose between the finger and thumb. (See figure #1)
6. Cover Victim's Mouth by placing your mouth completely over his with airtight contact. (See figure #2)
7. Blow Air into the victim's lungs until you see the chest rise (less forcefully for children); remove your mouth and let him exhale. If chest does not rise, check the position of his head and jaw (Steps #3 and #4); check for air passage obstructions.
8. Repeat the above steps 12 times a minute until victim revives. (20 times a minute for children)

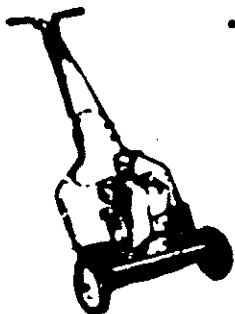
