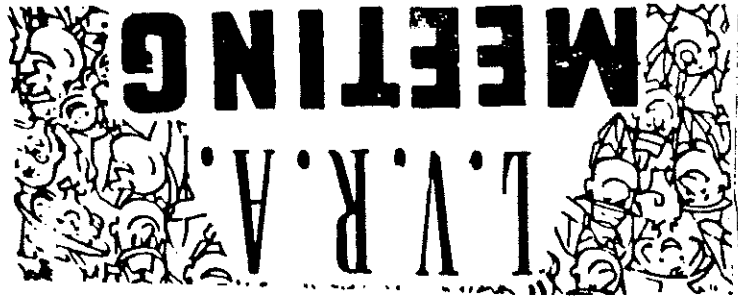
## VICE-PRESIDENT'S NEWS
