OCTOBER 1965

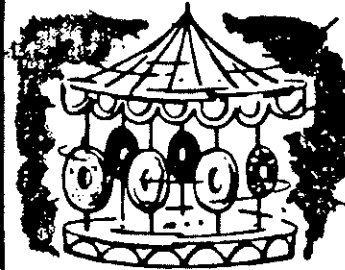

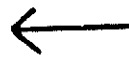
