 DIRECTORS TOOK OFFICE.

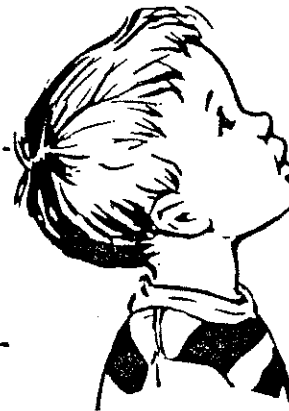
