L.V.R.A.  
MEETING

FAIRWOOD MULTI PURPOSE ROOM  
MARCH 7, 1966

ONCE UPON A TIME, THERE WAS A MAN NAMED BRANDEN, WHO BUILT HOUSES FOR A LIVING. HE BOUGHT SOME PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF SUNNYVALE AND BUILT SOME VERY NICE HOUSES ON THE PROPERTY, WHICH WAS DIVIDED INTO SECTIONS FOR EASE OF CONSTRUCTION. THE TRACT, (AS A DEVELOPMENT OF THIS NATURE IS CALLED), CAME TO BE KNOWN AS LAKEWOOD VILLAGE. THE SECTIONS WERE CALLED UNITS 1,2,3,4, FOR OBVIOUS REASONS.

NOW IT CAME TO PASS THAT SOME VERY NICE PEOPLE BOUGHT THESE HOUSES, NOT RICH PEOPLE, FOR THIS WAS A WORKING MANS AREA. THEY WERE PEOPLE WHO LIKE TO EAT, WHO LOVE THEIR CHILDREN, WHO LIKE TV, THEIR HOUSES AND YES, EVEN THEIR NEIGHBORS. BUT THERE WAS WHISPERING GOING ON --"DO YOU KNOW WE LIVE ON THE WRONG SIDE OF BAYSHORE?"--"WE ARE JUST THE STEP-CHILD OF SUNNYVALE"--"ALL THE DEAD BEATS IN SUNNYVALE LIVE IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE", AND SOME THINGS THIS PAPER COULD NOT ALLOW TO APPEAR IN PRINT.

THE PEOPLE WHO WERE REALLY INTEREST- IN THEIR OWN WELFARE AND THAT OF THEIR NEIGHBORS, RESENTED THIS ATTITUDE AND DECIDED TO DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT BESIDES SIT HOME AND GRIPE. THEY HELD A MEETING, OPEN TO THE VILLAGE, IT WAS DECIDED THAT THEY WOULD HAVE TO STICK TOGETHER TO GET THE PUBLIC FACILITIES THAT WERE SORELY NEEDED, PLUS ROADS, SEWAGE AND HELP IN RIDDING THE VILLAGE OF A HOARD OF CRICKETS THAT HAD INVADDED THE AREA. THERE WERE ONLY TWO UNITS AT THIS TIME, BUT WITH ENOUGH PHONE CALLS FROM ENOUGH PEOPLE, THESE CONDITIONS WERE CHANGED. CONDITIONS IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE HAVE BEEN CHANGING (FOR THE BETTER) EVER SINCE THEN. FROM THIS FIRST MEETING THE L.V.R.A.

WAS FORMED AND INCORPORATED MANY YEARS AGO. WE HAVE THE REPUTATION FOR BEING ONE OF THE FEW ASSOCIATIONS OF ITS KIND TO HOLD TOGETHER AS LONG AS IT HAS. THIS IS WONDERFUL ISN'T IT---OR IS IT???? CAN WE LET ALL THE PAST EFFORT GO TO WASTE AND LET EVERYTHING FALL APART NOW?

DID YOUR CHILDREN ENJOY THE SANTA PARADE? DID YOU PUT OUT SOME LIGHTS OR OTHER DECORATIONS FOR THE LIGHTING CONTEST? HOW DID YOU LIKE THE WESTERN DAY CELEBRATION LAST JULY? HAVE YOU EVER ATTENDED A LITTLE RENO NIGHT? DID YOUR KIDS FIND ANY EGGS AT THE EASTER EGG HUNT LAST YEAR? WILL THERE BE ANOTHER ONE THIS YEAR? HAVE YOU EVER WONDERED WHAT HAPPENS AT A POT LUCK DINNER OR WHAT THERE WAS TO EAT? WHAT KIND OF GAMES DO THE KIDS PLAY AT THE ANNUAL PICNIC?

THERE ARE MANY QUESTIONS, AND THEY ALL HAVE ANSWERS. DID YOU KNOW WHY IT TOOK SO LONG TO FINISH THE SECTION OF LAWRENCE EXPRESSWAY, ADJACENT TO LAKEWOOD VILLAGE?--- NO, THE STATE DID NOT HAVE TO WAIT FOR MORE MONEY TO BE ALOCATED. THE LVRA WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN HAVING IT HELD UP. WHY? BECAUSE THE PLANNING COMMISSION HAD INTENDED TO CLOSE ALL THE STREETS EXCEPT SANDIA ON THE ONE SIDE AND LAKEHAVEN ON THE OTHER, LEAVING US ONLY ONE STREET TO LEAVE OR ENTER THE VILLAGE, FROM EITHER SIDE. WE HAVE 1625 HOMES HERE AND PROBABLY TWICE THAT MANY CARS. IF A MEMBER OF THE LVRA, WHO ATTENDS THE PLANNING COMMISSION MEETINGS, OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, HAD NOT BEEN THERE, THIS WOULD BE OUR SITUATION TODAY. THE FIRE STATION, LOCATED ABOUT TWO MINUTES DOWN THE ROAD, IS ANOTHER EXAMPLE OF THE "SQUEEKING WHEEL GETTING THE GREASE". THE RESULTS AT THE LAST SCHOOL BOARD MEETING IS ANOTHER. THE LIST GOES ON AND ON WITH MORE HUMANE STORIES, THAT ARE NOT

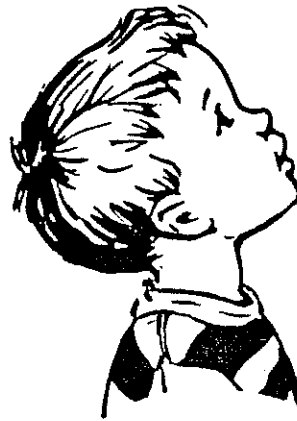

THIS IS AN OPEN LETTER TO THE PARENTS OF CURRENT AND FUTURE MEMBERS OF THE MILITAIRES: DEAR PARENTS:

WHILE WE ARE ON THE SUBJECT OF MONEY, I WOULD LIKE TO EASE THE MINDS OF PEOPLE WHO THINK THE ADULTS CONNECTED WITH THIS CORPS DRAW A SALARY. THERE IS NO COMPENSATION TO ANYONE FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN THIS CORPS, EXCEPT ONE PROFESSIONAL DRUM INSTRUCTOR. HIS FEE IS \$5.00 AN HOUR, BUT HE IS WELL WORTH IT. THIS IS STRICTLY A NON-PROFIT, NON-SPONSORED, SELF-SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION, AND THAT IS THE WAY IT WILL REMAIN. NOW WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOUR CHILD IS THAT

HE OR SHE BE IN THE 12-17 AGE BRACKET, HAVE A DESIRE TO JOIN AND BE A PART OF AN ORGANIZATION THAT WANTS TO WIN, AND BE ABLE TO FOLLOW OUR ESTABLISHED RULES AND REGULATIONS WITHOUT QUESTION. THE MEMBER MUST PAY AN ENTRY FEE OF \$3.00. THE DUES ARE \$2.00 PER MONTH THEREAFTER. THERE IS AN INSURANCE PREMIUM OF \$1.00 PER YEAR TO COVER MEMBERS DURING PRACTICE AND PARADE SESSIONS. THE TOTAL COST OF THEIR UNIFORMS IS LESS THAN \$30.00. YOUR CHILD NEEDS NO PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE, WE WILL TRAIN THEM. THAT IS OUR MOST IMPORTANT FUNCTION. YOU CAN HELP BY PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION TO PARADES, YOU CAN INSIST THAT YOUR CHILD PRACTICE HIS ASSIGNMENTS AT HOME, YOU CAN MAKE SURE THAT HIS DUES ARE UP TO DATE, YOU CAN GIVE HIM AND US A BOOST BY MAKING YOURSELF PRESENT AT OUR PRACTICE SESSIONS (THURSDAY NIGHT AT LAKEWOOD PARK REC. 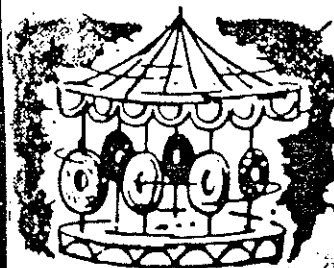

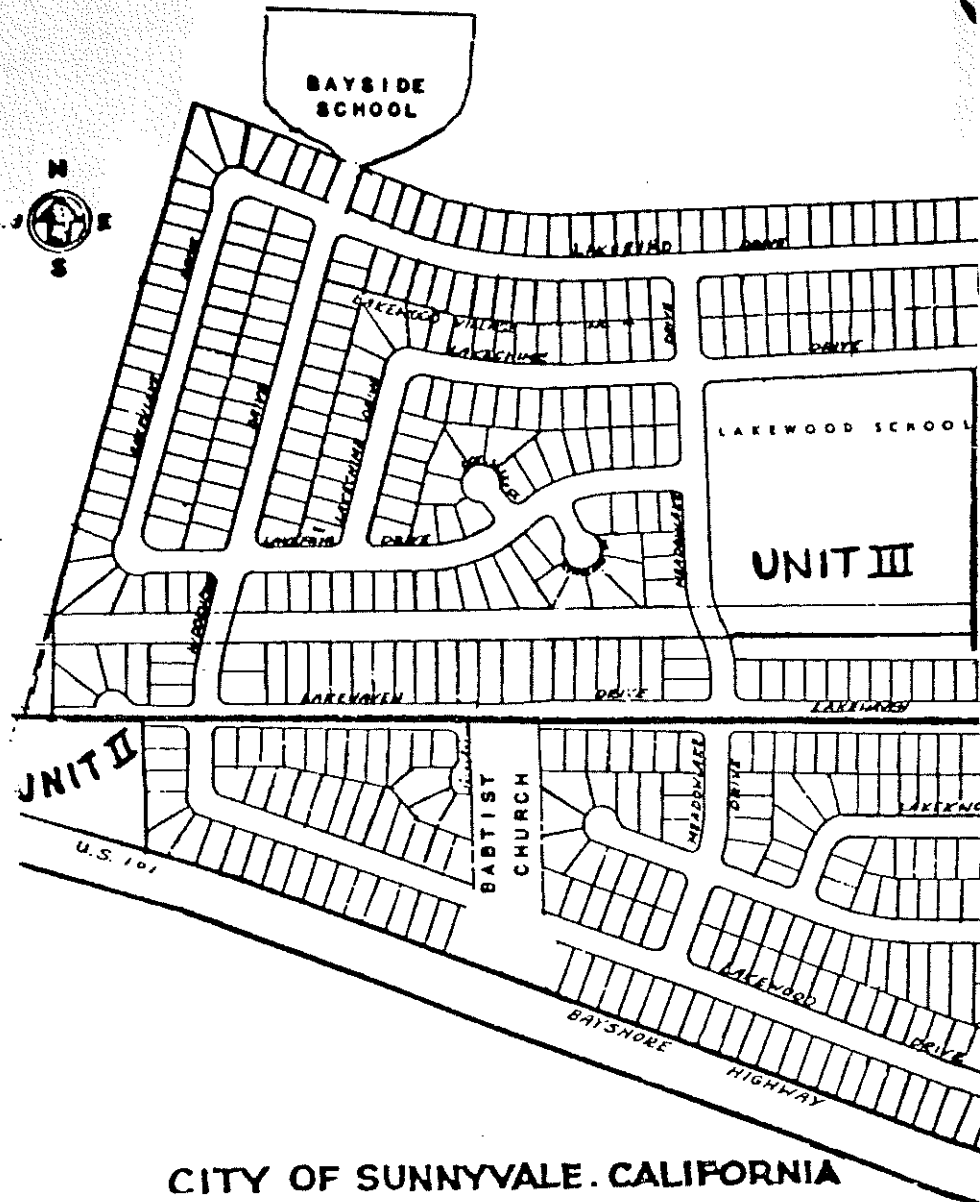

NOTES ON TROOP #425
