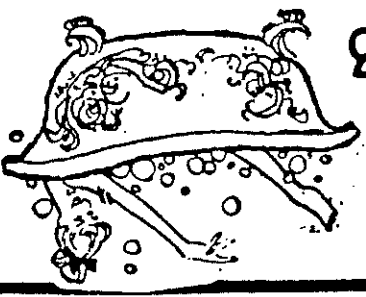


SPRING CLEAN UP

THE CHILDREN ARE SMALL AND RAGGED, BUT THEIR EYES SHINE AND THEY RUN AND SHOUT AND BE. THEY HANG ONTO YOUR HAND AND YOUR SHIRT TAIL AND BEG FOR HORSE-BACK RIDES. THEY SEARCH YOUR POCKETS DILIGENTLY FOR ANYTHING EDIBLE. ANY CHANGE IN YOUR POCKETS DISAPPEARS QUICKLY INTO THEIRS. THEY'LL DISMANTLE YOUR CAR IF THEY THINK THERE MAY BE A STICK OF GUM HIDDEN SOMEWHERE IN IT. THEY BEG TO BE HELD AND HUGGED AND LOVED. THESE ARE THE CHILDREN OF THE LITTLE ORPHAN-AGE WE VISITED LAST WEEK.

THESE CHILDREN -- 76 OF THEM -- LIVE IN PRIMITIVE CONDITIONS THAT WE CAN'T IMAGINE OUR CHILDREN LIVING IN. THE BUILDINGS ARE TOTALLY INADEQUATE. THE ELECTRICAL GENERATORS BREAK DOWN REGULARLY, AND THERE IS NOBODY TO REPAIR THEM. SO THEY ARE OFTEN WITHOUT ELECTRICITY.

THEY NEED EVERYTHING. YOU NAME IT -- THEY NEED IT. EVERYTHING FROM FOOD, TO SPOONS TO EAT IT WITH, AND THE NEED IS UNENDING.

MOST OF ALL RIGHT NOW, THEY NEED HELP TO GET THE BUILDINGS REPAIRED AND NEW ONES BUILT. THE ORPHANAGE WAS BEGUN BY A COM-PASSIONATE RETIRED MINISTER, REV. C. E. E, AND HIS WIFE. THEY TOOK CHILDREN INTO THEIR OWN HOME TILL THE PATTERN OF LIFE BECAME AN OVERWHELMING THUNDER OF LARGER QUARTERS -- FINALLY ENDING UP AT THE PRESENT LOCATION WHICH WAS ONCE A POLICE HEADQUARTERS.

THE BUILDINGS ARE APPROXIMATELY 10 YEAR OLD, AND LOOK IT. THEY HAVE BUILDINGS STARTED BUT HAVE NO FUNDS OR SUPPLIES MORE HELP TO PROCEED.

THERE ARE SO MANY MORE CHILDREN WHO NEED THE HELP THEY GET HERE, BUT THEY HAVE TO BE TURNED AWAY FOR LACK OF FUNDS AND FACILITIES AND ROOM.

MEXICO HAS NO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THESE CHILDREN, SO THEY CAN ONLY HOPE FOR HELP FROM SUCH PEOPLE AS REV. FRITZ. WE TOOK A LOAD OF CLOTHING TO THEM OVER EASTER, BUT WE CAN DO SO LITTLE ALONE AS COMPARED WITH WHAT THEY NEED.
