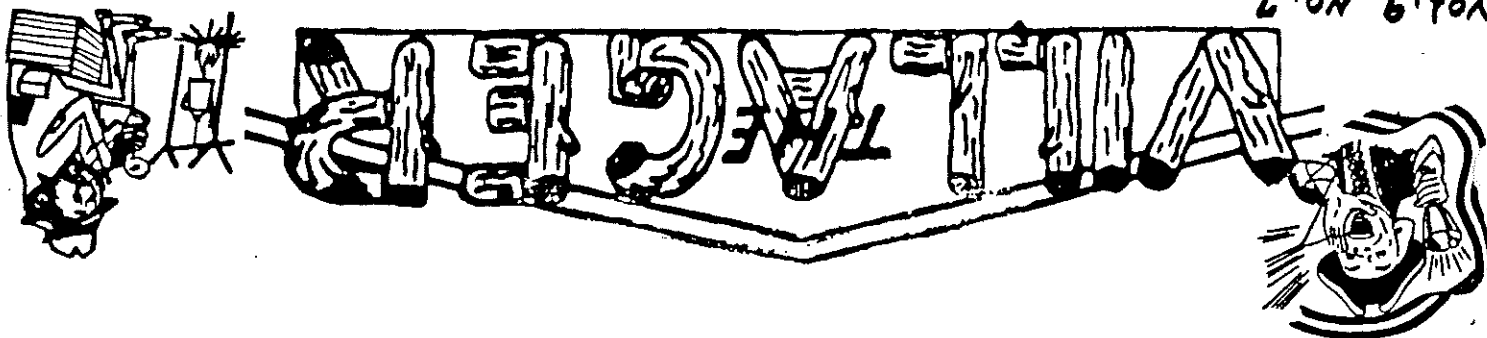

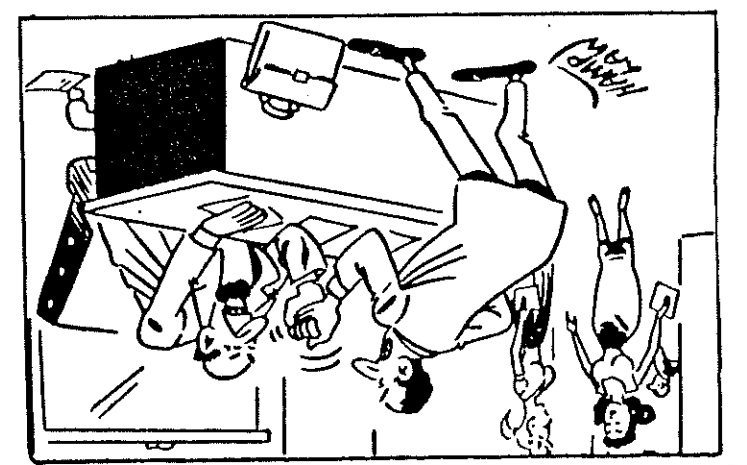

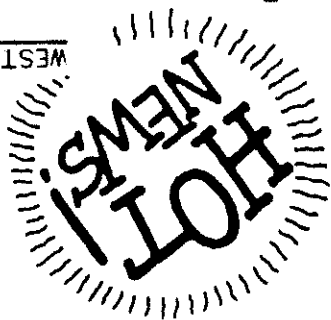

LAKEWOOD VILLAGE IS IN THE PROCESS OF BEING ORGANIZED UNDER THE NATIONAL "WAR ON POVERTY" PROGRAM, WHICH IS CARRIED ON IN SANTA CLARA COUNTY UNDER THE ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION.

THE COUNTY IS DIVIDED INTO NINE SERVICE AREAS. AREA NO. 7 INCLUDES SUNNYVALE AND SANTA CLARA. IN AREA NO. 7 THERE ARE EIGHT SUB-AREAS. SUB-AREA NO. 8 IS MADE UP MAINLY OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE.

AN INFORMATIONAL MEETING WAS HELD AT FAIRWOOD SCHOOL ON JUNE 23 AND ANOTHER IS TO BE HELD SOON. WATCH FOR NOTICES.

SUB-AREA NO. 8 WILL ELECT TWO REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AREA NO. 7. THOSE QUALIFIED TO VOTE ARE SINGLE PERSONS WITH AN ANNUAL INCOME UP TO \$3000, COUPLES WITH INCOMES UP TO \$4000 (OR UP TO \$6000 DEPENDING ON NUMBER AND AGE OF CHILDREN.) THE REPRESENTATIVES THEY ELECT DO NOT NECESSARILY HAVE TO BE IN THIS INCOME BRACKET.

ALSO, SUB-AREA 8 WILL ELECT ONE TO THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE TO CHOOSE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE "POOR" ON THE COUNTY COMMISSION.

THOSE ELECTED TO THESE POSITIONS WILL HELP SET POLICIES AND DECIDE WHICH PROGRAMS WILL BE OFFERED IN THIS AREA. OUR NEW AREA 7 DIRECTOR IS MR. JOSE LOPEZ. (246-0620)

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AREA 7 INCLUDES 15 CHOSEN BY AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS. REV. ROBERT SANFORD OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE IS ONE OF TWO REPRESENTATIONS OF RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS ON THE BOARD FOR THE TWO CITIES OF SUNNYVALE AND SANTA CLARA. IN ADDITION TO THE 15 CHOSEN BY ORGANIZATIONS ARE AGENTS, 15 OTHERS WILL BE CHOSEN TO REPRESENT THE "POOR" THROUGH THE 8 SUB-AREAS. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT PERSONS OF LIMITED INCOME TAKE AN INTEREST IN THE ORGANIZATION OF OUR LOCAL SUB-AREA NO. 8 IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE.

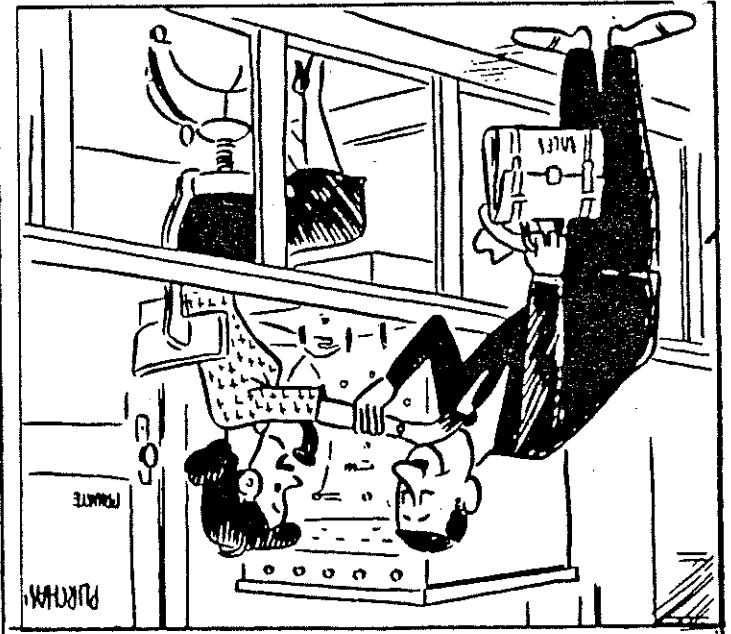

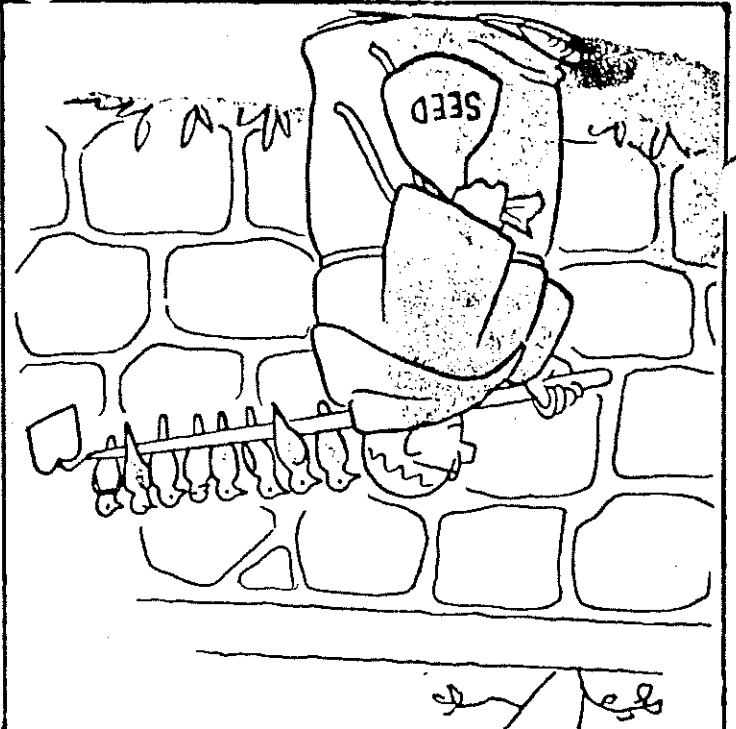

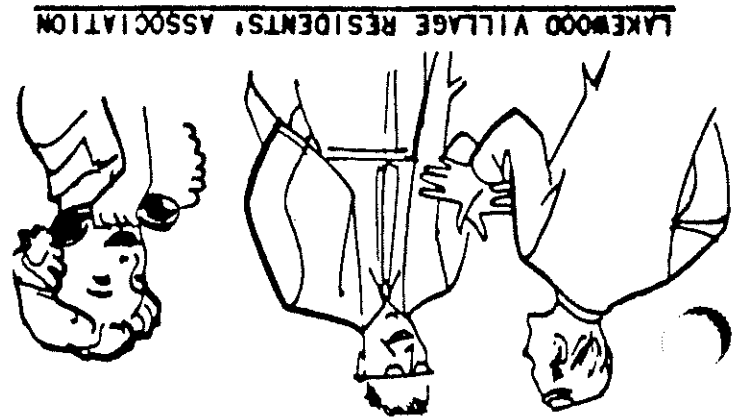
