I WILL LOOK FORWARD TO DISCUSSION OF THIS VITAL MATTER AT OUR NEXT GENERAL MEETING.

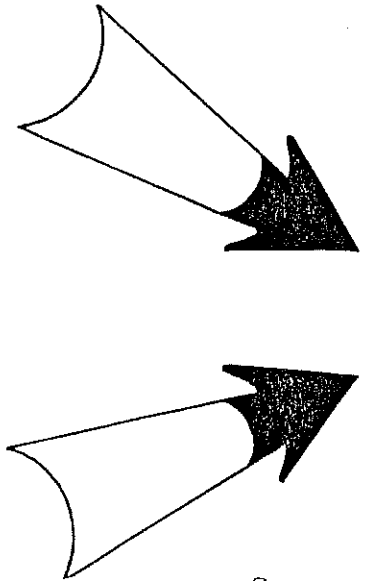
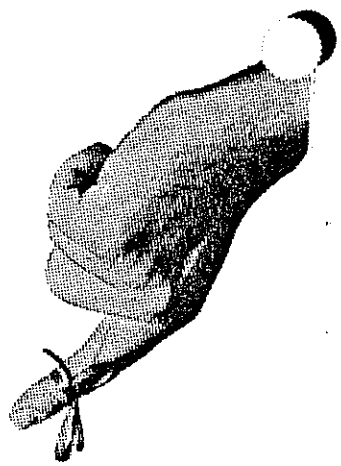

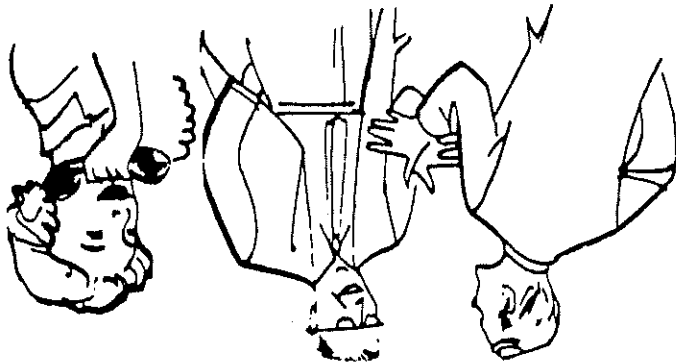
