



L.V.R.A. OFFICERS TO BE ELECTED



CITY COUNCIL DENIES TRAILER COURT APPLICATION

THE APPLICATION FOR REZONING OF A PARCEL OF LAND AT LAWRENCE EXPRESSWAY AND ELKO DRIVE, WHICH BORDERS ON LAKWOOD VILLAGE, HAS BEEN DENIED BY A UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE SUNNYVALE CITY COUNCIL.

LVRA PRESIDENT, JOE SANTI, POINTED OUT THAT NOT ONLY DID THE APPLICATION VIOLATE THE MINIMUM ELEVATION STANDARDS SET FOR RESIDENTIAL UNITS, BUT THAT THE ADDITION OF MORE THAN SIX HUNDRED DWELLINGS WOULD HAVE A CRITICAL EFFECT ON OUR ALREADY OVERCROWDED SCHOOLS.

MANY THANKS MUST GO TO THE PEOPLE WHO GAVE FREELY OF THEIR TIME TO COLLECT THE MANY SIGNATURES ON A PETITION, WHICH WAS PRESENTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL, PARTICULARLY VICKEY AND SINCLAIR CULLEN, WHO WERE ABLE TO COLLECT MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED FIFTY SIGNATURES, BY THEMSELVES.
