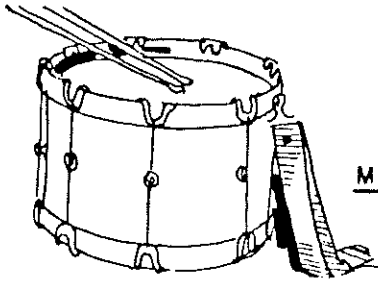

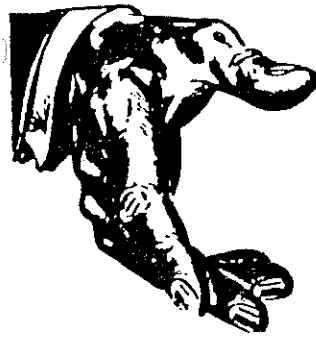

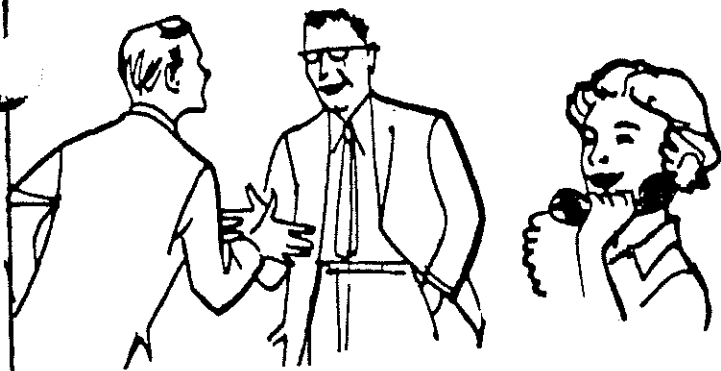

IT IS OFTEN SAID THAT GOD WANTS TO "COMFORT THE AFFLICTED AND TO AFFLICT THE COMFORTABLE."

LAKWOOD VILLAGE HAS ITS SHARE OF BOTH AND THE CHURCH HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO SPEAK FOR GOD TO THEM BOTH.

SOME OF US ARE QUITE COMFORTABLE IN MATERIAL WAYS, EARNING AND SPENDING MORE MONEY THAN EVER BEFORE.

SOME OF US ARE AFFLICTED, NOT ONLY BY LACK OF MATERIAL THINGS, BUT BY MANY KINDS OF PROBLEMS, INCLUDING ILL HEALTH, WORRY, FAMILY TROUBLE, ALCOHOL, PREJUDICE, AND UNREALISTIC DESIRES.

THE CHURCH WANTS TO COMFORT THE AFFLICTED BUT SOMETIMES IT DOESN'T KNOW HOW TO REACH THEM. SOMETIMES THE CHURCH (WHICH IS MADE UP OF PEOPLE) DOESN'T REALLY CARE ENOUGH ABOUT PEOPLE IN TROUBLE TO TRY HARD ENOUGH TO REACH THEM WITH REAL HELP.

THE CHURCH WANTS TO AFFLICT THE COMFORTABLE. WHY? BECAUSE WE LIVE IN A COUNTRY WHICH IS SLIPPING MORALLY AT AN ALARMING RATE. OUR CITIES ARE IN TROUBLE. MILLIONS ARE TRAPPED IN FRUSTRATING CIRCUMSTANCES AND NEED HELP BUT MOST OF THE COMFORTABLE DON'T CARE. THE VIETNAM WAR IS GIVING OUR COUNTRY THE REPUTATION THROUGHOUT THE WORLD OF BEING MORE DESTRUCTIVE THAN CONSTRUCTIVE IN THE FACE OF WORLD PROBLEMS.

BUT NEITHER THE COMFORTABLE NOR THE AFFLICTED ARE IN A FRAME OF MIND TO LISTEN TO THE CHURCH NOW . . . MOST OF THEM AT LEAST.

ONLY A FEW REALLY HAVE THEIR HEARTS AND MINDS OPEN TO THE GOSPEL THESE DAYS, EITHER THE GOSPEL THAT DISTURBS OR THE GOSPEL THAT COMFORTS.

IF YOU ARE AMONG THE FEW, I APPEAL TO YOU TO GO TO CHURCH. LISTEN. HELP. BE A SUPPORTING PARTICIPANT IN THE FELLOWSHIP. YOU ARE NEEDED AND YOU WILL GET WHAT YOU NEED.
