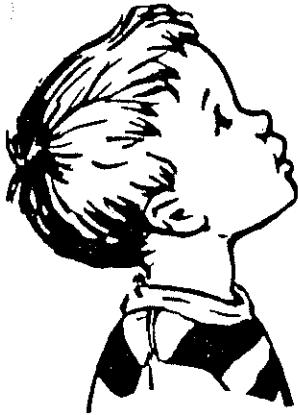

"AT WHAT AGE SHOULD RELIGIOUS EDUCATION BE STARTED?" PARENTS WHO ASK THIS QUESTION DON'T REALIZE THAT RELIGIOUS EDUCATION BEGINS BEFORE A CHILD IS BORN AND IS IN FULL SWING WHEN HE COMES HOME TO HIS LITTLE CRIB FROM THE HOSPITAL.

IF WE THINK OF RELIGION AS TRUST IN THE GOODNESS AND LOVE OF GOD AND FAITH IN THE WORTHFUL POSSIBILITIES OF LIFE, IT IS CLEAR THAT THE FOUNDATION FOR THIS IS LAID VERY EARLY.

LOVING PARENTS GIVE THEIR CHILD THE FEELING OF SECURITY WHICH A RELIGIOUS PERSON HAS WHEN HE IS ABLE TO BE CONSCIOUSLY AWARE OF THE LOVE OF GOD.

BABIES ARE VERY SENSITIVE TO AN ATMOSPHERE OF LOVE, ACCEPTANCE, AND CONCERN FOR THEIR NEEDS AND THEY BEGIN TO REACT IMMEDIATELY IN TRUST (OR MISTRUST, IF THE ATMOSPHERE IS LACKING.)

AS THE BABY GROWS HE BECOMES MORE AWARE OF HIMSELF AS A PERSON. LOVING PARENTS HELP HIM TO KNOW HIMSELF AS A PERSON OF UNLIMITED WORTH WHO IS ACCEPTED AND VALUED. OTHER PARENTS LEAD THEIR CHILDREN TO THINK OF THEMSELVES AS UNWORTHY AND UNACCEPTABLE.

THE FOUNDATION OF FAITH IN GOD IS LAID IN THE FIRST THREE YEARS OF LIFE.

A TRUSTING SPIRIT GIVES THE CHILD THE COURAGE TO FACE HIS OWN WRONG DOING, TO ADMIT IT AND ACCEPT FORGIVENESS. IT ENABLES HIM TO EXTEND THE CIRCLE OF TRUST BEYOND HIS FAMILY.

THE SUNDAY SCHOOL BUILDS ON THIS FOUNDATION, IN COOPERATION WITH THE HOME. MUCH LATER THE CHILD, NOW A YOUTH, HEARS THE "EVANGEL," THE GOOD NEWS OF GOD'S LOVE AND THE CALL TO A LIFE OF LOVE TOWARD OTHERS AND HE IS ABLE TO SAY, "I BELIEVE THIS." BUT THE FOUNDATION WAS LAID MUCH EARLIER. DEFICIENCIES CAN BE OVERCOME, BUT IT IS SELDOM EASY.
