OPEN LETTER

DEAR RESIDENTS:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS LETTER IS TO INFORM NEW RESIDENTS OF THE VALUE OF THE L.V.R.A. AND INFORM THEM OF JUST WHAT THE ORGANIZATION IS. THE L.V.R.A. IS THE LAKEWOOD VILLAGE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION FOR HOME OWNERS AND RENTORS ALIKE. ITS PURPOSE IS TO GIVE EACH INDIVIDUAL A VOICE IN THE CITY COUNCIL AND TO KEEP OR BUILD A GOOD-CITY IMAGE OF THE AREA AND TO KEEP NEEDED IMPROVEMENTS CONSTANT. WE WANT TO INFORM NEW RESIDENTS AND OLD ALIKE THE VALUE OF THE ASSOCIATION AND REPORT THE PROGRESS MADE SINCE ITS INCEPTION.

THE L.V.R.A. HAS THE DISTINCTION OF BEING THE OLDEST CONTINUED ASSOCIATION OF ITS KIND IN THE ENTIRE NORTHERN HALF OF CALIFORNIA AND POSSIBLY THE ENTIRE STATE.

THE PROGRESS REPORT IS AS FOLLOWS:

MAY 1958 THE VILLAGER WAS BORN. IT IS A NEIGHBORHOOD PAPER DESIGNED TO KEEP YOU INFORMED OF EVERYTHING GOING ON PERTAINING TO YOU. NEWS FROM YOU AND ABOUT YOU.

DUE TO THE "REMOTE" LOCATION OF LAKEWOOD VILLAGE IN RELATION TO SUNNYVALE, A REPRESENTATIVE WAS SENT DURING THIS YEAR TO THE CITY COUNCIL TO LET THEM KNOW OUR NEEDS.

DECEMBER 1958 THE FIRST LIGHTING CONTEST WAS HELD.

APRIL 1959 THE FIRST PUBLIC FORUM WAS HELD FOR THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM IN FAIRWOOD SCHOOL.

JUNE 1959 LAKEWOOD VILLAGE SPONSORED A LITTLE LEAGUE TEAM NAMED THE "FALCONS". THIS TEAM WAS SPONSORED SEVERAL YEARS.

DECEMBER 1959 THE FIRST SANTA CLAUS PARADE WAS HELD FOR THE ENTERTAINMENT OF THE CHILDREN.

SEPTEMBER 1961 AN ATTEMPT WAS MADE TO HAVE A FIRE STATION LOCATED NEAR US. THE NEAREST ONE TO THE VILLAGE WAS 4.3 MILES. THE TIME INVOLVED IN REACHING A FIRE AT THIS DISTANCE WAS ALMOST TOO

LONG TO SAVE ANYTHING OR ANYONE. **MAY 1962** LAWRENCE EXPRESSWAY AND ELCO DRIVE WAS THE LOCATION DECIDED UPON FOR THE LOCATION OF THE FIREHOUSE.

OCTOBER 1963 CONSTRUCTION WAS BEGUN ON THE FIREHOUSE ABOUT ONE AND ONE HALF YEARS AHEAD OF THE SCHEDULED "TIME OF NEED". THE CITY COUNCIL DECIDED THAT CONSTRUCTION ON STATIONS 4, 5 AND 6 WOULD BE STARTED AND OPENED SIMULTANEOUSLY. THIS WAS DONE TOO, IN EARLY 1963.

AUGUST 1963 THE L.V.R.A. STARTED PETITIONING FOR OUR PARK. IT WAS ESTIMATED THAT THE COST WOULD BE \$300,000.00. IT WAS FOUND THAT THE NEED WAS TRUE AND WORK WAS BEGUN.

SEPTEMBER 1964 THE LAKEWOOD PARK WAS DEDICATED.

THE L.V.R.A. WAS ALSO INSTRUMENTAL IN GETTING PORTABLE CLASSROOMS FOR OUR SCHOOLS.

APRIL 1965 THE FIRST EASTER EGG HUNT WAS HELD IN THE PARK FOR THE CHILDREN.

JULY 1965 OUR FIRST WESTERN DAYS WERE HELD IN THE SHOPPING PLAZA WITH ENTERTAINMENT INTENDED FOR AND BY ALL RESIDENTS.

MARCH 1969 A PUBLIC FORUM WAS HELD FOR THE CITY COUNCIL CANDIDATES AT BAYSIDE SCHOOL. THIS INCLUDED AN INFORMAL COFFEE TIME AND A QUESTION AND ANSWER PERIOD.

1968, 69 SCHOOL YEAR IT WAS DURING THIS TIME 4-WAY STOP SIGNS WERE INSTALLED AROUND OUR SCHOOLS. IT WAS FIRST DECIDED DOWN-TOWN THAT TRAFFIC DIDN'T WARRANT THESE SIGNS HOWEVER, CLOSE INVESTIGATION WAS MADE BY RESIDENTS AND PROOF OF NEED WAS TAKEN TO THE COUNCIL AND THE SIGNS WERE INSTALLED.

IN THE SUMMER OF 1969 CROSSWALKS WERE PAINTED ON THE STREETS TO ENABLE OUR CHILDREN TO HAVE A BIT MORE SAFETY. LANES WERE PAINTED ON LAKEHAVEN AND SPEED LIMITS WERE MADE NOTICIBLE. PLEASE NOTE: THE SPEED LIMIT IN THE VILLAGE IS NOT 50 M.P.H., AS YOU MAY BELIEVE BUT A MERE AND SAFE 25 M.P.H., AS IN OTHER CITY RESIDENTIAL AREA.

THE L.V.R.A. FURTHER REPRESENTING THE DESIRES OF THE RESIDENTS WHO MADE THEMSELVES HEARD, PETITIONED THE CITY NOT TO ALLOW APARTMENT BUILDINGS WHERE ADOBE WELLS IS NOW LOCATED. OUR SCHOOLS COULD NOT TAKE THE ADDITIONAL CHILDREN.

A PARKING BAN WAS MADE IN THE SHOPPING PLAZA IN FRONT OF ONE END OF THE ROW OF STORES. THE PURPOSE OF THIS BAN AND THE BARRIERS IS FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN WHO MAY DASH FROM BETWEEN PARKED CARS AND THEY NOW HAVE A PLACE, OTHER THAN THE SIDEWALK, TO RIDE AND PARK THEIR BICYCLES. THESE BARRIERS ALSO ELIMINATE THE SEATS THAT WERE PROVIDED THE LOITERERS. HOW MANY TIMES DID YOU COME OUT OF THE STORES TO FIND SOMEONE SITTING ON YOUR CAR AND VERY BELIGERENTLY REFUSED TO REMOVE THEMSELVES? THE ELIMINATION OF PARKING IN THIS AREA ALSO PROVIDES A CLEAR VIEW INTO THE SHOPS THEREFORE GIVING BETTER POLICE PROTECTION FROM THE CONSTANT STEALING AND FREQUENT WINDOW SMASHING.

FUTURE IT IS IN THE "MILL" THAT APARTMENTS WILL BE BUILT AROUND THE HOLIDAY INN ALONG WITH A CONVENIENCE SHOPPING AREA.

LAWRENCE EXPRESSWAY IS TO BE WIDENED TO THREE LANES WITH A PEDESTRIAN OVERCROSSING FROM ONE HALF OF THE VILLAGE TO THE OTHER. ANOTHER MOBILE-HOME PARK WILL BE BUILT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND CASA DE AMIGOS MEANING THE REMOVAL OF THE DAIRY FARM THAT GIVES US THE RURAL AROMA.

THE ASSOCIATION IS HAVING AN ELECTION OF OFFICERS IN MARCH. VOTING ELIGIBILITY REQUIRES THAT YOU BE A PAID-UP MEMBER. IF YOUR MEMBERSHIP IS DUE IN MARCH AND YOU'VE NOT BEEN CONTACTED CALL MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN CAROL BOGLE 734-1148 AND A REPRESENTATIVE WILL CALL ON YOU. IF YOU ARE A NEW RESIDENT, HOME OWNER OR IF YOU RENT AND ARE INTERESTED IN MEMBERSHIP, DUES ARE \$2.50 PER YEAR AND INCLUDES THE ENTIRE FAMILY. THE LADY OF THE FAMILY THEN IS CORDIALLY INVITED TO ATTEND OUR MONTHLY AUXILIARY MEETINGS AND HELP PLAN AND EXECUTE VILLAGE ENTERTAINMENT.

REQUIREMENTS FOR HOLDING AN OFFICE ARE THAT YOU BE A PAID-UP MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING AND HAVE A SINCERE DESIRE TO IMPROVE THE VILLAGE AND CAN GIVE SOME OF YOUR TIME. IF YOU ARE IN THIS CATEGORY CALL CAROLYN CONGDON 734-1796. MRS. CONGDON IS THE NOMINATING CHAIRMAN, OR ATTEND THE FEBRUARY GENERAL MEETING, FEB. 2ND

DID YOU KNOW THAT THIS IS AN ELECTION YEAR?

IF YOU HAVE MOVED SINCE THE LAST ELECTION, EVEN ACROSS THE STREET OR NEXT DOOR, YOU MUST RE-REGISTER.

CALIFORNIA RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS MAY BE DIFFERENT FROM THE LAST PLACE YOU LIVED.


YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IF YOU WILL BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD, A RESIDENT OF CALIFORNIA ONE YEAR, A RESIDENT OF SANTA CLARA COUNTY 90 DAYS, AND ARE REGISTERED AS A VOTER AT YOUR PRESENT RESIDENCE AND IN YOUR PRESENT PRECINCT AT LEAST 54 DAYS BEFORE THE NEXT SUCCEEDING ELECTION.

A NEW STATE LAW AUTHORIZES POST CARD REGISTRATION PROVIDED THAT YOUR ONLY CHANGE IN STATUS IS A CHANGE OF ADDRESS WITHIN THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA. THESE SPECIAL POST CARDS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE SUNNYVALE POST OFFICE, 141 SO. TAAPFE STREET. IF FOR ANY OTHER REASON YOU MUST RE-REGISTER, FOR INSTANCE, YOU WISH TO CHANGE YOUR PARTY AFFILIATION OR YOU'VE BEEN DROPPED FROM THE ROLLS FOR FAILURE TO VOTE IN PAST ELECTIONS, NEW AFFIDAVITS MUST BE FILED EITHER AT THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE, 456 W. OLIVE OR PUBLIC SAFETY HEADQUARTERS, 515 SO. MATHILDA AVENUE. ALL VOTERS ARE NOTIFIED BY MAIL ABOUT 10 DAYS BEFORE EACH ELECTION, WHERE TO VOTE AND THE SUBJECT MATTER.

ANY FURTHER INFORMATION REGARDING REGISTRATION OR ELECTIONS CALL THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS OFFICE IN SAN JOSE, TOLL FREE, 299-2161.

THIS WHOLE "PREJUDICE" THING IS SCIENTIFICALLY AND MORALLY WRONG.

PREJUDICE IS BASED ON FEAR AND IGNORANCE. IT ASSUMES THAT CERTAIN GROUPS OF PEOPLE ARE INHERENTLY DIFFERENT FROM "US." THEREFORE, "THEY" MUST ALWAYS BE SEPARATED FROM "US" AND AVOIDED, TREATED WITH SUSPICION, OR KEPT DOWN.

ALL THIS IS BASED ON FALSEHOOD. HUMAN BEINGS ARE INHERENTLY THE SAME NO MATTER WHAT SOCIAL, RACIAL, NATIONAL, OR OTHER CLASS GROUPS THEY BELONG TO. YET ALL HUMAN BEINGS ARE DIFFERENT, EVEN IN THE SAME FAMILY. SO, IF WE ARE TRUE TO THE FACTS, WE RESPECT ALL HUMAN BEINGS AS ALIKE AS A SPECIES AND DIFFERENT AS INDIVIDUALS.

PREJUDICE IS IMMORAL. ALL RELIGIONS TEACH US TO "LOVE OUR NEIGHBOR." LOVE DOESN'T MEAN FEELING "MUSHY" TOWARD SOMEONE. LOVE IS A "DESIRE TO HELP." TO "LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR," "LOVE EVERYONE," OR "LOVE YOUR ENEMY" THIS MEANS TO HAVE GOOD WILL TOWARD HIM AND WANT TO HELP HIM IN ANY WAY YOU CAN.
