THE LAST LVRA MEETING

THE TURN-OUT AT OUR MARCH GENERAL MEETING WAS THE BEST I'VE SEEN FOR SOME TIME.

THE ELECTION OF OUR OFFICERS TOOK PLACE AND ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- VICE PRESIDENT - BILL KOHRT
- SECRETARY - POLLY BEMIS
- TREASURER - STEVE COOLLEY
- UNIT DIRECTORS - (REPRESENTATIVES)

- BOB WILSON

LET'S GIVE THESE PEOPLE ALL THE SUPPORT WE CAN DURING THE COMING YEAR. THEIR TIME IS DONATED TO OUR CAUSE AND THEY ARE HERE TO SERVE YOU AS BEST THEY CAN.

LT. ROBERT DALE AND LARRY KLAR, REPRESENTING THE SUNNYVALE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT, WERE PRESENT TO ANSWER QUESTIONS ABOUT WHAT IS BEING DONE AND CAN BE DONE IN REGARD TO OUR PROBLEMS WITH THE YOUNG PEOPLE IN OUR AREA.

IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT, NUMBER ONE, LAKEWOOD VILLAGE IS NOT UNIQUE, THESE SAME TYPE OF PROBLEMS OCCUR ALL OVER SUNNYVALE. SECONDLY, WE LEARNED THAT PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO IMPROVE RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN YOUTH AND PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS ARE UNDERWAY AT SUNNYVALE HIGH SCHOOL. IT WAS FURTHER RECOMMENDED THAT WE ASK OUR OWN YOUTH, SPECIFICALLY THE O.Y.A., FOR ASSISTANCE IN ACCEPTING RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR OWN ACTIONS THROUGH A PROGRAM OF SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS GIVEN TO NON-TROUBLE MAKERS.

IT WAS ALSO NOTED THAT PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS MUST BE NOTIFIED OF INCIDENTS IN ORDER TO TAKE ANY ACTION. DON'T COMPLAIN TO YOUR NEIGHBOR, REPORT ALL INCIDENTS TO THE SUNNYVALE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE. OFFICERS ARE GIVEN THREE OPTIONS WHEN FACED WITH TROUBLE INVOLVING JUVENILES; (1) RELEASE TO PARENTS, (2) TICKET TO APPEAR WITH PARENTS IN COURT, (3) TAKE BODILY TO JUVENILE HALL.

WE AS CITIZENS MUST DO OUR PART TOO. SEE THAT A BLOCK PARENT PROGRAM IS INITIATED IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD THROUGH THE CTA. DON'T BE AFRAID TO MAKE A CITIZEN'S ARREST. THE PROCEDURE TO FOLLOW IF YOU WITNESS A CRIME (EVEN FOUL LANGUAGE IN THE PRESENCE OF WOMEN & CHILDREN IS A MISDEMEANOR OF DISTURBING THE PEACE), IS TO CALL THE POLICE. WHEN THEY ARRIVE PLACE YOUR HAND ON THE PERSON COMMITTING THE ACT AND TELL HIM YOU ARE PLACING HIM UNDER ARREST. THIS SERVES THE SAME PURPOSE AS THE OFFICER ACTUALLY WITNESSING THE EVENT.

UNFORTUNATELY, I HAVE THE FEELING THAT SOME PEOPLE LEFT THE MEETING FEELING THAT NOTHING HAD BEEN ACCOMPLISHED. UPON REFLECTION, I'M SURE THAT YOU MAY REALIZE THAT IF NOTHING ELSE, PERHAPS AT LEAST A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE SITUATION IS NOW APPARENT.

I HAVE BEEN TOLD, SINCE THE MEETING, THAT WE HAVE NO RIGHT TO EXPECT LAKEWOOD VILLAGE TO HAVE LESS CRIME THAN OTHER PARTS OF SUNNYVALE. I DISAGREE! WE HAVE EVERY RIGHT, IF WE ARE WILLING TO EARN THE RIGHT THROUGH OUR OWN ACTIONS! WE HAVE ALL THE EQUIPMENT, MANY FINE PEOPLE LIVE IN LAKEWOOD VILLAGE BY CHOICE. OUR PEOPLE WORK IN ALL TYPES OF JOBS AND ARE INTERESTED IN CIVIC RESPONSIBILITIES.

LAKEWOOD VILLAGE HAS A YOUTH BASEBALL ORGANIZATION MANAGED AND ORGANIZED BY LAKEWOOD PEOPLE, WE HAVE CHURCHES THAT HELP THE COMMUNITY IN MANY WAYS, WE HAVE SCHOOLS DOING THEIR PART IN COMMUNITY EFFORTS, SO, WHY CAN'T WE HAVE A NEIGHBORHOOD FREE OF CRIME? WITH ALL THE GOOD WE HAVE GOING FOR US, WHY LET THE BAD TAKE OVER?

IN SOME CASES PERHAPS WE CARE MORE THAN OTHER NEIGHBORHOODS ABOUT OUR COMMUNITY, SO IF THE TROUBLE MAKERS ARE COMING FROM ELSEWHERE (A STATEMENT I'VE HEARD REPEATEDLY) BECAUSE THEY THINK THIS IS AN EASY PLACE TO PULL THEIR SHENANIGANS, LET US TAKE A PERSONAL STAND AND PROVE THEM WRONG.

RED, WHITE & GREEN

AS PROMISED LAST MONTH WE WILL DISCUSS WHAT TO DO TO PLANTS AND FLOWERS IN SPRING.

MULCH: BEFORE GROWTH APPEARS, MULCH THE ROSE BEDS WITH WOOD SHAVINGS, REDWOOD SAWDUST, PEAT MOSS, OR AGED STEER MANURE. A HEAVY MULCH ELIMINATES WEEDS AND CONSERVES MOISTURE THRU DRY PERIODS.

WATERING: CONTINUE TO KEEP PLANTS WELL WATERED. IT IS ADVISABLE TO HILL-UP PLANTS HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME BREAKING DORMANCY.

FEEDING: ABOUT APRIL 1, GIVE EACH ESTABLISHED ROSE BUSH ABOUT A HALF CUP OF WELL-BALANCED FERTILIZER. DO NOT FEED NEW BUSHES UNTIL AFTER THEIR FIRST BLOOMING PERIOD AND THEN FEED LIGHTLY. SOME MAY WISH TO EXPERIMENT WITH FOLIAR FEEDING.

SPRAYING: AS SOON AS LEAVES APPEAR--SO DO APHIDS. A LIGHT SPRAY OF WATER ONLY EACH DAY WASHES THEM AWAY. TO CONTROL FOR LONGER PERIODS YOU MAY WISH TO USE SOME OF THE NEWER SYSTEMATICS AVAILABLE NOW. SOME OF THESE MATERIALS ARE SOPHISTICATED ENOUGH TO CONTROL SUCKING AND CHEWING INSECTS; OTHERS HAVE SYSTEMIC FUNGICIDES ADDED, AND STILL OTHER SPRAY MATERIALS HAVE A CONTROLLED RELEASE OF NITROGEN--

SO IN ESSENCE ARE A FERTILIZER AS WELL. FOR SPECIFIC PROBLEMS SUCH AS RUST, RED SPIDER, MILDEW ETC., CHECK YOUR NURSERY MAN'S SHELF OR ASK ANY CONSULTING ROSARIAN. READ ALL LABELS CAREFULLY -- WHEN IN DOUBT USE 1/2 RECOMMENDED AMOUNTS UNTIL YOU ARE SURE OF THE RESULTS.

CAUTION: TREAT ALL MATERIALS AS POISONS AND KEEP OUT OF CHILDREN'S REACH.
