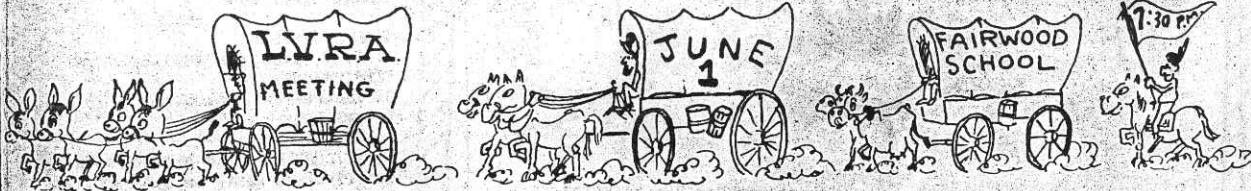

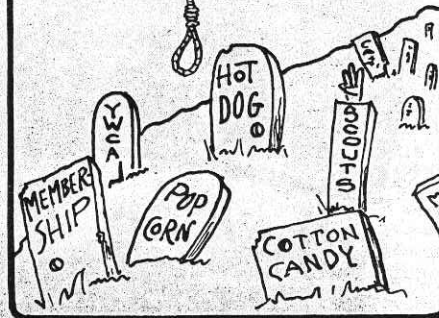

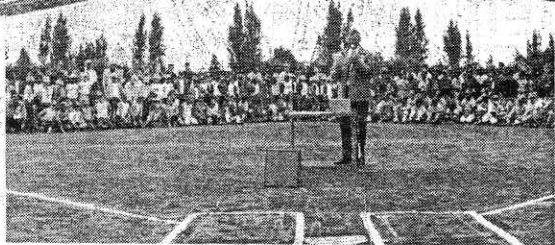
RAIN THREATENED, BUT THE TURN OUT OF FANS WAS GREAT.

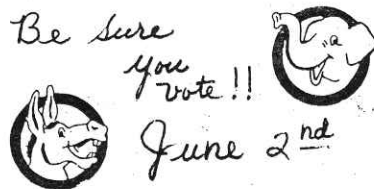
THE TROOP WON A RED RIBBON FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE CAMPOREE IN APRIL.

Announcement

THE ABORTION INITIATIVE PETITION WHICH IS CURRENTLY BEING CIRCULATED NEED 325,000 SIGNATURES BY JUNE 8 TO GET IT ON THE CALIF. STATE BALLOT IN NOVEMBER.

THE ABORTION INITIATIVE PETITION WOULD ALLOW A WOMAN AND HER PRIVATE PHYSICIAN TO CHOOSE WHEN SHE WILL BEAR A CHILD AND WOULD REMOVE THE HOSPITAL COMMITTEE REVIEW FROM THE LAW. PRESENT COMMITTEE JURISDICTION CAN ONLY BE REMOVED BY LEGISLATIVE ACTION SUCH AS THE PETITION, NOT BY THE COURTS.

IN THE PAST YEAR THE THERAPUTIC ABORTION ACT HAS HELPED ONLY 12% OF THE WOMEN WHO GET ABORTIONS IN THE STATE. MOST WOMEN WHO GET ABORTIONS STILL CHOOSE TO GO UNDERGROUND. THE NEED FOR PRIVACY HAS SHOWN ITSELF TO BE GREATER THAN THE NEED FOR HIGH QUALITY MEDICAL CARE. THIRTY-SEVEN PERCENT OF PREGNANT WOMEN IN THE COUNTRY GIVE BIRTH UNWILLINGLY TO AVOID THE TRAUMA AND DISGRACE OF HAVING TO PROVE TO A HOSPITAL COMMITTEE THAT THEY ARE PHYSICALLY OR MENTALLY UNABLE TO BEAR CHILDREN.

THE YOUNG WOMEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION (YWCA) AT THEIR RECENT CONVENTION IN HOUSTON, TEXAS, CALLED FOR THE "REPEAL OF ALL LAWS RESTRICTING OR PROHIBITING ABORTIONS PERFORMED BY A DULY LICENSED PHYSICIAN".

NOW YOU HAVE A CHANCE TO PLACE ON THE CALIF. BALLOT THE ISSUE OF WHO IS TO DECIDE WHETHER OR NOT YOU WILL ASSUME THE AWESOME RESPONSIBILITY OF MOTHERHOOD—YOU OR THE STATE. AT PRESENT IT IS THE STATE THAT DECIDES. WOMEN SHOULD NOT BE SHACKLED BY THE PRESENT CRUEL AND ARCHAIC ABORTION LAW OF OUR STATE.

THE LAST LVRA MEETING

THE MAY 6TH GENERAL MEETING OF THE LVRA WAS GRACED WITH TWO GUEST SPEAKERS.

MR. HOLMES CROUCH, CANDIDATE FOR COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR IN THE JUNE ELECTION, GAVE AN INFORMATIVE TALK ON THE CURRENT PROCESSES USED BY TAX ASSESSORS TO ASSESS PROPERTY AND SOME OF HIS IDEAS FOR IMPROVEMENTS ALONG THESE LINES.

MR. GARY O'RIELLY FROM THE SUNNYVALE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE EXPLAINED WHAT A CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IS AND HOW IT CAN BE USEFUL TO CITIZENS AND MERCHANTS. THE LVRA MEMBERS WHO WERE PRESENT MADE SUGGESTIONS ON POSSIBLE IMPROVEMENTS FOR DOWNTOWN SUNNYVALE.

MEMBERS FROM THE LVRA SOCIAL COMMITTEE WERE PRESENT TO TRY TO CLEAR UP A FEW POINTS ABOUT THE OPERATION OF THEIR COMMITTEE. IT WAS VOTED TO ALLOW THE COMMITTEE TO RETURN TO THE WAY IT HAD OPERATED PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 1970.

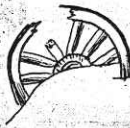

FAVORITE OF MANY TEENAGERS. ELLER'S SUBTITLE IS "THE TEN COMMANDMENTS RE-VISITED."

ALTHOUGH THE EDITORS OF MAD (WITH TONGUE IN CHEEK) LOUDLY DENY ANY SUCH RIGHTEOUS INTENTIONS, THEY LET ELLER (A PROFESSOR OF RELIGION), DO HIS BOOK AND ABINGDON (A CHURCH PUBLISHING HOUSE) PUBLISH IT.

EACH CHAPTER DEALS WITH ONE OF THE TEN COMMANDMENTS, WITH APPROPRIATE HILARIOUS SELECTIONS FROM ISSUES OF MAD.

ELLER SEES MAD'S HUMOR AND SATIRE AS HELPING KIDS BECOME FREER PERSONS.
