THE LAST LVRA MEETING

Watering the Lawn

IDEALLY, a lawn needs an inch-deep rainfall once a week during the growing season. This is about what it averages in most of the temperate United States. Any lawn can go a couple of weeks without water, and a strong lawn—cut high, with roots reaching for moisture a foot down—can survive droughts of a couple of months.

It is better not to water at all than to water lightly, since a light sprinkling doesn't penetrate deeply and forces roots to turn upward for the water. A full inch of water will go deep. To cover 1000 square feet with water an inch deep takes 750 gallons. A sprinkler delivering three gallons a minute (a fairly typical rate) therefore requires 250 minutes, or over four hours, to soak that area.

SANTA CLARA COUNTY'S ANIMAL POPULATION IS EXPLODING, FIGURES FROM THE HUMANE SOCIETY INDICATE.

IN MAY AND JUNE, THE SOCIETY HANDED 17,169 STRAY AND UNWANTED DOGS AND CATS, DIRECTOR RICHARD DENNEN REPORTED.

CATS WERE THE BIGGEST PROBLEM - 11,359 OF THEM WENT THROUGH THE SHELTER WHICH HAS SPACE FOR ONLY 100. A FEW OF THEM WERE CLAIMED AND A FEW ADOPTED BUT THE VAST MAJORITY WERE PUT TO SLEEP, DENNEN SAID.



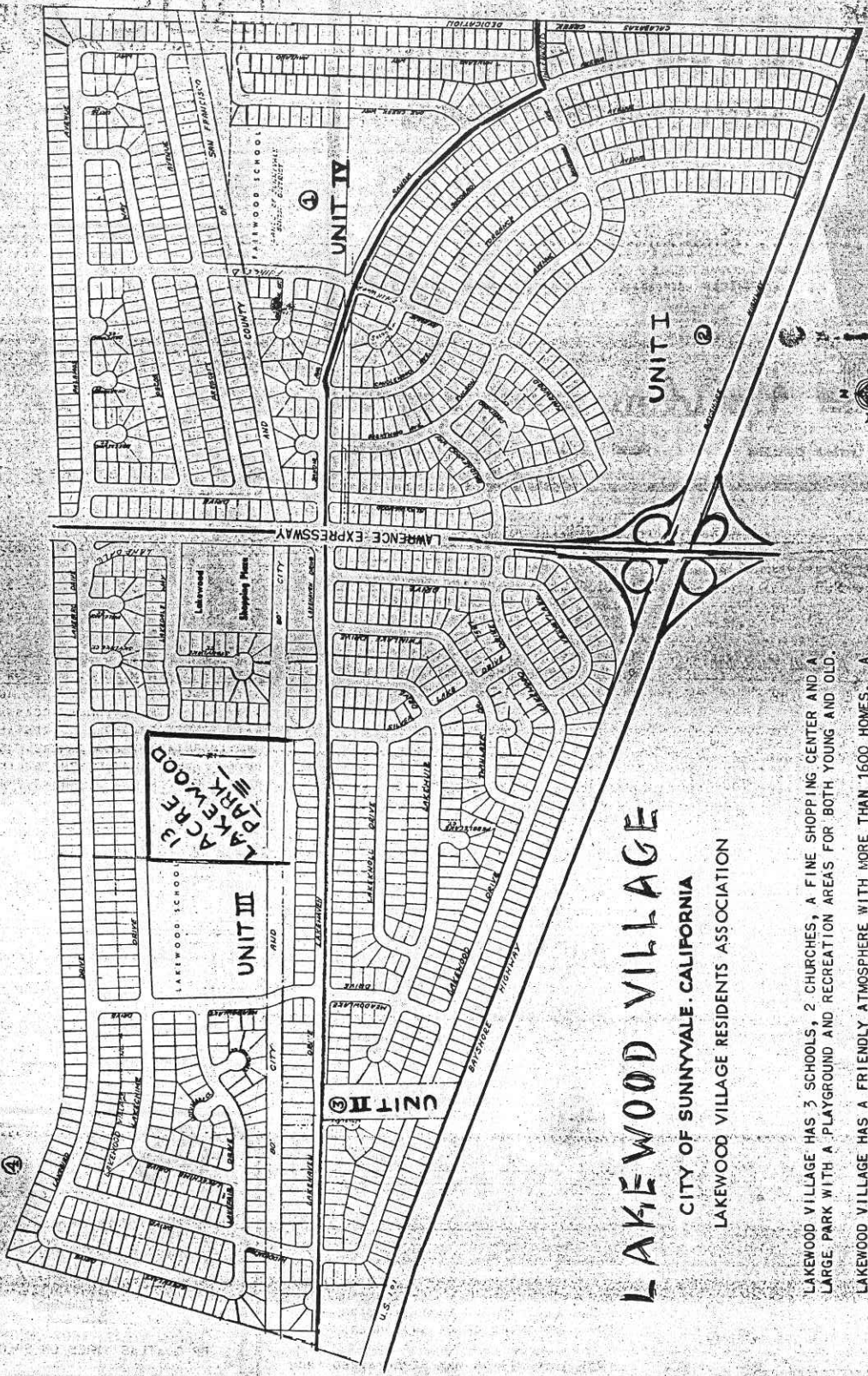
