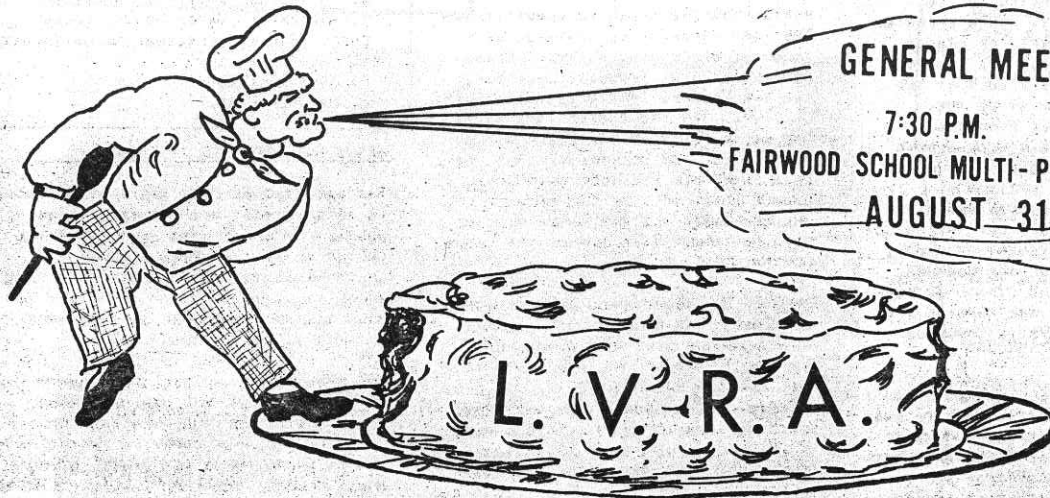

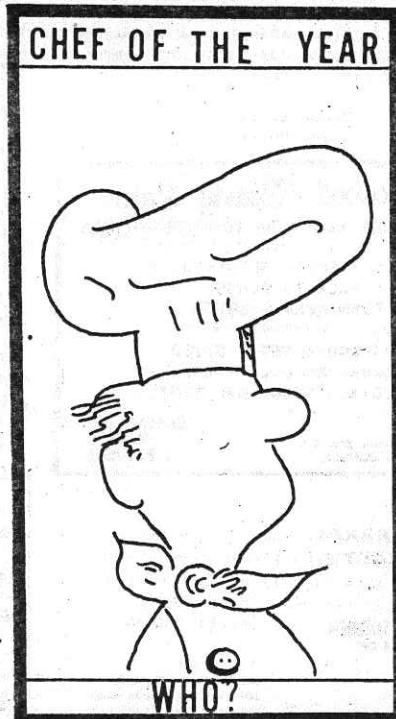

EDITORIAL

ACCORDING TO WEBSTER'S THIRD NEW INTERNATIONAL DICTIONARY, THE DEFINITION IS:

1: HAVING OR SHOWING LITTLE OR NO FEELING OR EMOTION: SPIRITLESS, IMPASSIVE. 2: HAVING OR SHOWING LITTLE OR NO INTEREST OR CONCERN: INDIFFERENT.

IT IS A SAD EXPERIENCE TO WITNESS APATHY. IT IS TERRIFYING TO SEE THE RESULTS OF APATHY. WHEN EFFORTS ARE MADE FOR THE BENEFIT OF OTHERS AND THE RESULT IS ZERO, THE EFFORTS WILL SOON CEASE. THE RESULT OF THE CESSATION OF EFFORT MUST BE THE COLLAPSE OF ANY OR ALL PROJECTS. THERE WILL BE EXTREMELY WIDE-SPREAD DISASTER WHEN NOBODY CARES ANY MORE.

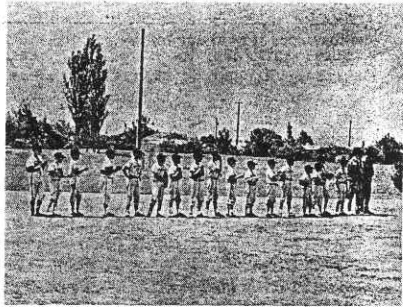

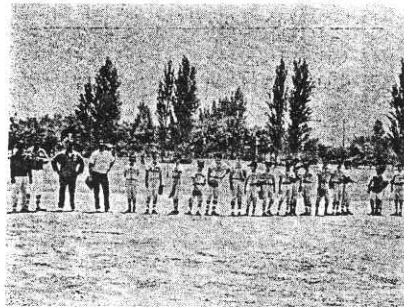

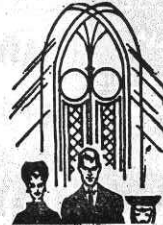
