EDITORIAL

IT HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO OUR ATTENTION THAT OUR SIGNALS HAVE BEEN MISSED BY MANY IN REGARD TO ATTENDANCE AT THE GENERAL MEETINGS. WE HOLD THESE PUBLIC MEETINGS THE FIRST MONDAY OF EACH MONTH AT FAIRWOOD SCHOOL MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM. MEMBERSHIP IN THE L.V.R.A. IS NOT A REQUIREMENT FOR YOUR ATTENDANCE. MARRIED OR SINGLE, ALL RESIDENTS ARE EXTENDED AN INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE WHENEVER YOU ARE INTERESTED IN HEARING THE SUBJECT OF THE CURRENT SPEAKER OR JOINING IN OUR ACTIVITIES, E.G., THE SPOOK HOUSE.

ALL BUSINESS MEETINGS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC ESPECIALLY SINCE CIVIC ISSUES ARE DISCUSSED AND DECISIONS ARE MADE THAT COULD POSSIBLY AFFECT YOU OR YOUR PROPERTY.

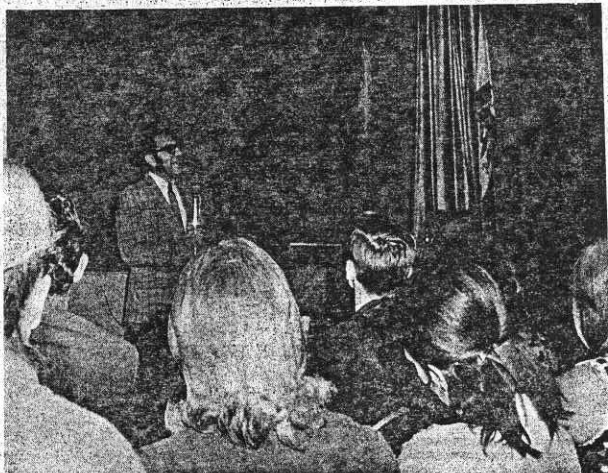

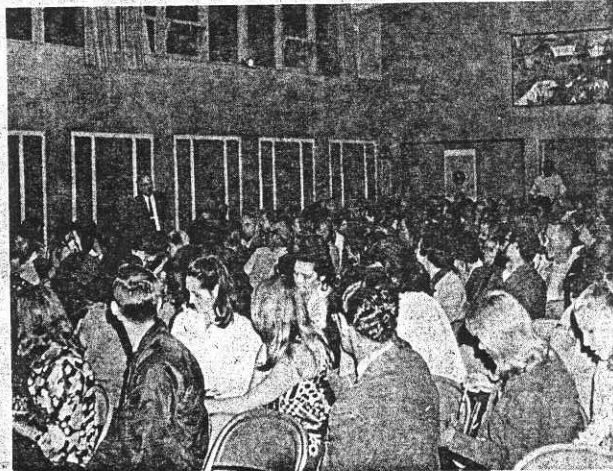

THE LAST LAKEWOOD VILLAGE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION MEETING

THE L.V.R.A. GENERAL MEETING ON OCTOBER 5TH WAS HELD IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE P.T.A. GROUPS OF OUR THREE SCHOOLS, BAYSIDE, FAIRWOOD & LAKEWOOD. THE TURNOUT WAS TREMENDOUS.

THE L.V.R.A. PORTION OF THE MEETING WAS BRIEF. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND STANDING COMMITTEES GAVE THEIR REPORTS. MARY SANTI, CHAIRMAN, TOLD OF THE SOCIAL COMMITTEE'S PROGRESS ON A FLOAT FOR THE CUPERTINO PIONEER DAYS PARADE ON OCTOBER 17, & ASKED HENRY MOORE, PRESIDENT, TO RIDE AS OUR REPRESENTATIVE. PHYLLIS KOHRT, EDITOR, THE VILLAGER, ANNOUNCED THAT THE SEPTEMBER ISSUE HAD PAID FOR ITSELF. GENE MENDOZA, CHAIRMAN, OF THE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE, MENTIONED THAT THE MEN'S BAKE-OFF WAS A SUCCESS AND THAT LOTS OF YOUNG PEOPLE HAD RESPONDED TO CALLS TO WORK ON THE HALLOWEEN SPOOK HOUSE. FOLLOWING IS A SUMMARY OF ADVICE TEACHERS GAVE PARENTS WHOSE CHILDREN PARTICIPATED IN THE LINDENHURST REMEDIAL READING PROGRAM.

TALK TO YOUR CHILD. HELP HIM TO ADD WORDS TO HIS SPEAKING VOCABULARY. THE MORE WORDS HE USES NATURALLY IN HIS ORDINARY CONVERSATION, THE MORE WORDS WILL HAVE MEANING FOR HIM WHEN HE SEES THEM ON THE PRINTED PAGE.

LISTEN TO YOUR CHILD. CHILDREN MUST HAVE MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO EXPRESS THEMSELVES. ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO TALK ABOUT THINGS HE HAS SEEN OR DONE. THE MORE THE CHILD TALKS, THE BETTER HE IS LIKELY TO READ.

HELP HIM WITH HIS READING. TELL HIM THE WORDS IF HE'S IN THE BEGINNING STAGES OF READING. HELP HIM WORK OUT THE WORD IF HE'S IN A LATER STAGE BY LOOKING AT THE PICTURE, SKIPPING OVER THE UNKNOWN WORD AND READING THE REST OF THE SENTENCE TO SEE WHETHER THIS SUGGESTS A NEW WORD.

READ TO YOUR CHILD. A CHILD WHO HAS BEEN READ TO IS USUALLY MORE ANXIOUS TO READ TO HIMSELF. READING BECOMES MORE IMPORTANT. REMEMBER, HIS LISTENING AND INTEREST LEVELS ARE ABOVE HIS READING LEVEL.

TEACH YOUR CHILD HOW TO TAKE CARE OF BOOKS. HE WILL THEN LEARN TO REGARD BOOKS AS FRIENDS.

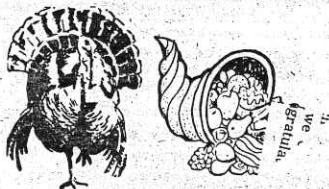
