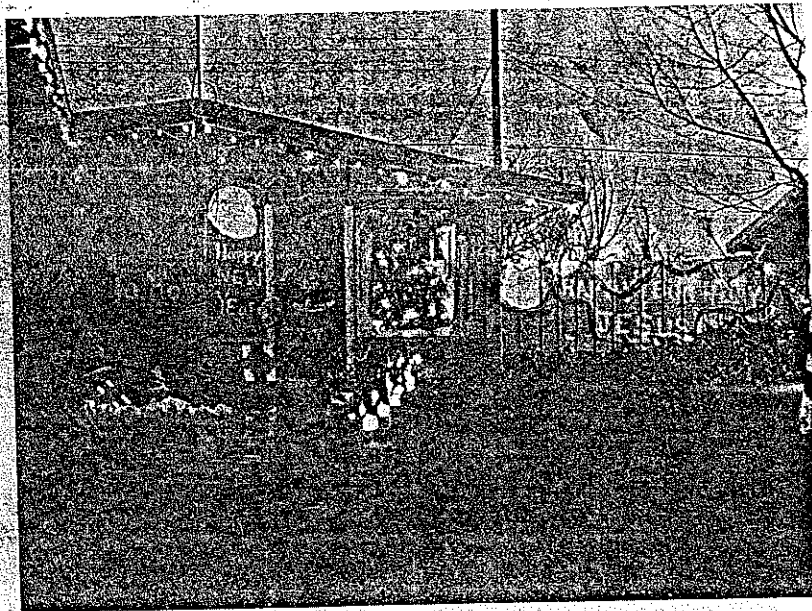

AT APPROXIMATELY 2:00, DECEMBER 20TH ON SUNDAY AFTERNOON THE SANTA CLAUS PARADE STARTED FROM THE SCHEDULED PLACE WITH L.V.R.A. PRESIDENT HENRY MOORE IN THE LEAD ESCORTED BY MR. & MRS. NICK SIMOLA.

IT BEGAN TO RAIN ABOUT 1:30 AND DECIDED NOT TO STOP, SO IT WAS QUITE AN ORDEAL WHEN THE PARADE GOT UNDER WAY BUT THE HARDY GROUPS THAT CONTINUED WERE LED BY NOAH'S ARK.

BROTHER NOAH'S ARK WAS AN OUTSTANDING AND UNUSUAL ENTRY THIS YEAR, AND WAS CAPTAINED BY BOB WILSON WHO STEERED IT ON ITS WINDING COURSE. CAMP FIRE GIRLS GROUP 9, DECORATED THE ARK WITH CUTE STUFFED ANIMALS AND WORE COSTUMES THEY DESIGNED THEMSELVES REPRESENTING VARIOUS ANIMALS. MRS. NOAH (MRS.
